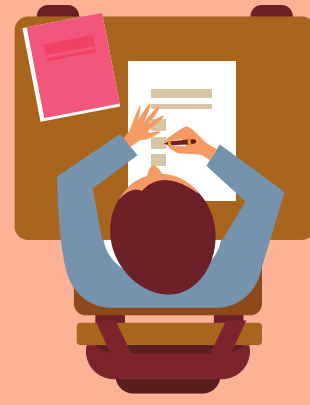


Schedule of Books*

- To introduce students to a challenging classic book
