We will provide you with A3 tracing, layout and graph paper as well as A2 paper for mood board work

Please bring the following items with you for the course:

One technical drawing pen - a Ticky disposable pen is fine but a quality Rotring pen is even better. If you are using a Rotring pen you will need ink or cartridges. A College Set of pens is preferable for the Diploma course, with nib sizes 0.5mm, 0.35mm and 0.25mm so you may choose to invest in those now. Rapidograph uses an ink cartridge, and the Isograph is refilled from an ink bottle that will come with the set.

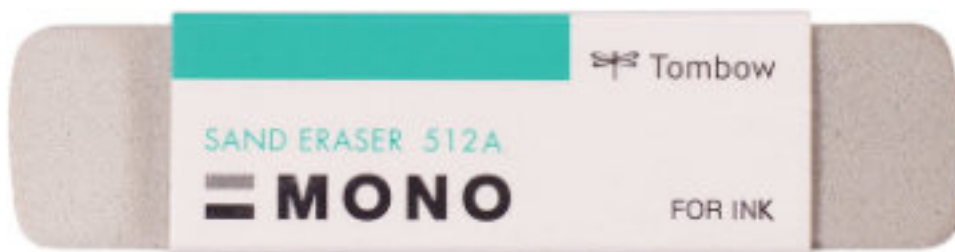


College set

The college set comes with a mechanical pencil which is fine to use, but Caroline recommends this, Twist Erase pen also.



Ink erasers are tricky to get right. These are good, but we will also discuss this on the course. We have some that can be borrowed if necessary. Please note that the eraser that comes with the ink pen set, only rubs out pencil!



Metal ruler - plastic is fine but metal is also useful for cutting in the future

Masking tape

Bring any magazines that are able to be cut up – these do not have to be gardening related – there are some in the studio you can use if you don't have any.
