Course Description:

Systemic inflammation is the primary factor related to chronic breakdown of our complete health. There is a strong relationship between periodontal inflammation and systemic inflammation. This workshop will provide participants an in-depth understanding of oral infection, inflammation, and the relationship to systemic health and disease. The workshop will be experiential in that participants will use their own personal test results and samples of patient reports to demonstrate best practices in patient communication, next steps, and treatment planning.

Gain the knowledge and the ability to make meaningful differences in our patients' lives through professional awareness, interdisciplinary practice with other medical professionals, patient education, screening, diagnosis, and treatment of systemic inflammation and infection.

- 5. Discover how to collaborate with other medical specialists to address oral and systemic inflammation
