



COVID-19 Protocols

As part of the Dogma difference, we are doing everything we can to ensure we are preventing the spread of the virus and keeping everyone safe. We have increased our cleaning protocols throughout the facility. Team are wiping down surfaces every 30 minutes and washing their hands regularly. Any team member who is not feeling well is being asked to stay at home. We ask that if you are in self-isolation or are not feeling well, that you please stay home and follow all current AHS guidelines. We have made changes to our programs and operations which are outlined below.

Group Classes:

Our group classes are currently running, along with some specialty clinics. We have strict policies in place to keep everyone safe and practice social distancing. This includes:

- A max of 6 dogs per class with two family members allowed per dog.
- Assigned seating with a taped off area for each student to work in with their dog
- Hand-sanitizing stations available
- Electronic tracking of your dog's progression
- No sharing of treats or equipment
- Masks must be worn at all times by team and students.

Not comfortable to attend in person? As part of your membership, you can attend virtual sessions live or watch them at your convenience for one week after the session. Our memberships include access to a comprehensive online training program with obedience, handling, self-control and manners skills as well as webinars on behaviour problem solving, canine communication and more!

Day School:

There is no evidence to show that the virus can be spread through fur or dander, but precautions still need to be made. We will continue with our cleaning protocols to help prevent the spread of the disease and offer continued support to dogs and their families:

- Doors at both facilities are locked.

- Our team will come to your vehicle and take your dog from the back or a rear seat to maintain a safe social distance. Please wear a mask if you must leave your vehicle to get your dog out/in.

- Please leave personal belongings at home such as bedding or toys as they will not be allowed to come with your dog into the building.
- You may continue to bring their treats or food in a sealed container.
- Payments can be made through our online store, over the phone, or via E-Transfer.

Private Training:

We can still offer private training support during this time and have a few contactless options available:

- **Virtual consults:** these can be done via video or over the phone. Our certified trainers can help answer any questions you may have regarding your dog's behaviour. They will also summarize the session and provide you with a written report, along with any related resources.
- **Dog-dog assessments:** we can do these through our contactless protocols at day school. One of our certified trainers will bring your dog into our facility and live-stream the session with you. There is no need to delay your dog's training or risk a regression in their behaviour currently.
- **We are currently only offering in-home training to members. Everyone must be masked at the session.**
