JOB DETAILS

- >> This is a remote contractor position. You'll create your own schedule within project deadlines. You can work anywhere you have an internet connection. You can even work in your pajamas. In fact, our unofficial company uniform is comfy pants and a messy bun.
- >> Projects will begin on June 22, 2021 with weekly deadlines throughout the summer. There is also potential opportunity to continue during the school year.
- >> Payment is project-based (equivalent to \$25.00/hour). After 8 weeks, you will also receive full access to all of our of reading, writing, math & classroom decor collections.
- >> You'll need to be able to commit to 8-15 hours each week for the summer.



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's Degree (must be in an education area advanced degrees preferred)
- 3+ recent years as a classroom teacher in grades 1-3 or elementary literacy specialist position
- strong communication skills (written and verbal)
- proficiency in Google Slides and Google Docs
- comprehensive understanding of state and national literacy standards (CCSS, TEKS, etc)


YOUR ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- You will be combining your educational background, teaching experiences, understanding of best practices and your passion for picture books to make a positive impact on hundreds of thousands of children on a global level.
- You'll be supporting teachers by creating lessons and activities they can easily implement in their classrooms. Best of all, they will do so with enthusiasm and confidence knowing they're providing meaningful, engaging, and interactive learning opportunities that are accessible to all their students.
- You will be fostering a love of learning in students and helping them to develop a greater understanding of people, places and situations. You will make it possible for children to see themselves, learn about others, build schema and increase their interest in and appreciation for the diverse world that is waiting for them to make a difference in it.

For each book companion project, you will be responsible for...

- >> writing a summary of the story
- >> identifying and defining key words that will strengthen a child's vocabulary and deepen their comprehension of the text
- >> developing standards-based comprehension questions/discussion starters and providing possible responses
- >> pinpointing examples of well-written mentor sentences and making suggestions for grammar and writing lessons that can be taught using the author's craft as an authentic model
- formulating 30 writing prompts (three each for ten types of writing) based on the story
- analyzing the events of the story to determine social emotional learning topics and composing talking points to promote those skills and foster character-building

- 1) Make a copy of the practice template.
- 2) Rename your copy as: YOUR LAST NAME, YOUR FIRST NAME | LITERACY TEAM APPLICATION
- 3) Set the share settings to "anyone with a link can view."
- 4) When you fill out your Google Form application, you will need to copy and include the link to your work sample.

Complete the sample project. The Google slide presentation includes everything you need to complete the task. If you do not have a copy of the book, there is a link to the story being read aloud on slide 1. There are blue text boxes throughout the presentation with directions for each section.
