

Love Lives Here!

This gorgeous wreath is accented with burlap and pearls for the perfect combination of farmhouse and fancy!

Supplies

Each crafter will need:

1.5" Burlap Roses 4 each 3.5" Burlap Roses 2 each 5 ft **Grapevine Garland** 1 ft **Berry Garland** Pearls (6 mm) 6 each Burlap 1 vd **Paint Sticks** 14 each

Following are the quantities to make 20 projects (you will have some leftover supplies due to the minimum increments required by Darice). Total material cost = approx \$10 per project.

- The instructions include steps to make burlap roses. It is cheaper, but somewhat difficult and time consuming (but totally doable if you want to save money!)
- ** Paint Sticks from your local hardware store or Amazon. Look for a higher quality/sturdy stick for best results.



Additional Supplies Needed

Scissors Paint & Brushes **Graphite Paper**

Font Stencil

Hot Glue Gun

Wood Glue

Pencil

Sand Paper





- Put lotion on your fingers when working with hot glue to keep from getting burned.
- When cutting burlap, always cut along one line so the edges are straight.
- Watch the video, particularly the clip on making the roses.
- There is enough burlap to make extra flowers if desired.



















STAIN: 2/3 brown + 1/3 black

Plaque

- Arrange 12 PAINT STICKS, RULER SIDE UP, with indents in alternating directions.
- Use WOOD GLUE to glue sticks together; do not glue the indented sections. Make sure plaque does not stick to your work surface.
- Being more generous with the WOOD GLUE, glue the last 2 paint sticks across all the other sticks at opposite ends. Allow a few minutes to dry.
- Flip your plaque over and SAND any glue globs. Use a damp PAPER TOWEL to remove any dust from the plaque.
- Purple Brush: Mix STAIN and paint the front, back and edges of the plaque. Immediately wipe off paint with a damp paper towel & set aside to dry.

2 Burlap

CUT a 24" piece of burlap. Of that piece, cut pieces of these sizes: 7"x3/4"

18"x2" 12"x1.5" (2) 9"x1.5"

(2) 6"x3/4" 2"x6" (3) 1"x6"

3 Asters (6"x3/4" & 7"x3/4" Burlap Strips)

Run HOT GLUE along the bottom seam side and roll the burlap. Cover the bottom of the roll with hot glue. PULL strands of burlap from the top of the roll to save for later use. REPEAT this with the other 6"x3/4" strip and the 7"x3/4" strip.

4 Roses (18"x2", 9"x1.5" and 12"x1.5" Burlap Strips)

- ☐ Using the 18"x2" strip, fold it in half lengthwise with the edge slanted/ askew. Run HOT GLUE along the top edge and seal the ends together.
- FOLD the triangular end over, and then fold it again and glue. Fold the top edge down, wrap it and glue it. Continue this process until your rose is complete. REPEAT for the (2) 9"x1.5" strips and the 12"x1.5" strip.

5 Stencil

- Align the PAPER TEMPLATE in the center of the plaque. Place graphite paper under the template and trace with pencil.
- ☐ Black Brush: Using WHITE paint with a few drops of water, OUTLINE the words. Fill the letters "L-O-V-E" with an angled scribbled stroke.

6 Assembly

- Rip stems of BERRIES from the branch.
- Wrap 2"x6" strip of BURLAP around the wreath and HOT GLUE to seal. Insert 4 of the reserved burlap strands and tie together to form a loop for hanging. Twist the loop so the tie is hidden in the burlap.
- TIE (3) 1"x6" strips of burlap and remaining strands of burlap onto the wreath where desired.
- Slide PIP BERRY STEMS into the wreath and bend stems to contour the wreath. Glue at the base of stems if necessary.
- ☐ Set ROSES and ASTER on the wreath as desired, then HOT GLUE into place.
- ☐ HOT GLUE the wreath onto the plaque.
- HOT GLUE a PEARL in the center of each rose.
