California Legislative Action Committee - CLAC Moment





2018 Legislative Day at the Capitol April 8-9, 2018

Raise your hand if you live in a condominium community with balconies or other exterior elevated elements like walkways or staircases.



If you raised your hand, SB 721 should be at the top of your mind, like it is for CLAC. This bill passed the State Senate in January with bipartisan support.

SB 721 would require your Association to inspect and assess the structural performance of 15% of the balconies and elevated exterior elements every six years. It is estimated an inspection will cost \$5,000 per element. Do the math!!

If you are alarmed or concerned by what you are hearing, pull out your cell phone now and send a direct message via on Facebook (using the Town Hall feature) to your State Senator and Assembly Member to Stop SB 721. If you don't have Facebook, commit to me right now that when you get home or back to your office that you will send the same message via email, text, or Pony Express.

The other way to get involved is to join us in Sacramento for CAI-CLAC Legislative Day in the Capitol scheduled for April 8-9. SB 721 will be a top priority and we need your voice to help stop it. To sponsor or attend the event, go to the event page on CLAC's website, www.caiclac.com.
