Register to vote and check your registration at MWEG's Election Central: mweg.org/electioncentral.

DECIDE HOW YOU ARE GOING TO VOTE 🐸

- See what's on your ballot at Election Central.
- Check your secretary of state's website to see what your voting options are. Choose the option that is best for you and your family. That may include:

In-person Voting — Early In-person Voting —

- Absentee or Vote-by-Mail

IF VOTING BY ABSENTEE OR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT ➤

- Apply for your absentee or vote-by-mail ballot today!
 - Scroll to the clickable map at **Election Central**.
 - If your state is blue on the map, no need to apply! All registered voters in your state will receive a ballot.
 - If your state is red or pink on the map, verify that you are eligible to vote absentee or by mail on your secretary of state's website.
 - If eligible, click your state's name to apply for a ballot.
 - Submit your application. Know the deadline, and submit early!
 - Follow up with your election office if you do not receive confirmation or if your ballot does not arrive within two weeks.
- Once you receive your ballot, fill it out.
 - Make sure to read and follow ALL instructions. Leave no errant marks, tears, or stains.
 - Sign your ballot! Read the instructions to see if your state requires additional verification methods.
 - Provide your phone number and email address, if asked, so your ballot can be cured if there are any questions.
 - Return your ballot ASAP according to the instructions.
 - Document it with pictures that provide date verification.
 - Add correct postage, if needed.
- Track your ballot.

IF VOTING IN PERSON ₩

- Check your voter registration again before heading to the polls.
- Find your polling place location, polling dates, and hours, and see what you need to bring to vote at **Election Central**. (Don't forget your mask!)
- Go vote! And be prepared for longer-than-usual wait times.
