Ideas for a Fishless Fisherman Bible Lesson:

Read aloud **The Fishless Fisherman**, and as you do, have someone dress up in funny fisherman clothes (include anything you can find – big fishing hat, rubber boots, rubber

pants, fishing pole, fishing net, fishing shirt, fishing tackle, fishing pole, boat supplies, and any random fishing/boating items you can find – including random Christian "fish" items (Christian coffee cups or fish-logo decorations) to make the fisherman look funny.

Talk about what makes someone a fisherman or fisherwoman — is it fishing clothes and fishing stuff, or going to a fishing "club" or is a person a fisherman if they catch fish?

Make sure to emphasize to children that the CHURCH is good. We meet and worship together and learn from God's Word, the Bible. But we also need to OBEY and to GO.

- What did Jesus mean when He told His disciples to be fishers of men?
- What did Jesus mean when He told His disciples to "launch out into the deep"?
- What is ONE way you can share your faith with others?
- Who is ONE person you know who needs Jesus?
