

## Ranking of Hands

Seconds Left x Multiplier (60/75/90/120 seconds) = Score

### Royal Flush

Ace thru 10

Same Suit

Multiplier = 17/13.6/11.33/8.5



### Straight Flush

Straight, No Ace

Same Suit

Multiplier = 15/12/10/7.5



### Four of a Kind

4 Cows of

Same Rank

Multiplier = 5.5/4.4/3.67/2.75



### Full House

3 of Same Rank

+ 2 of Same Rank

Multiplier = 6/4.8/4/3



### Flush

Any Mix

Same Suit

Multiplier = 6.5/5.2/4.33/3.25



### Straight

Any Consecutive

w/Mixed Suits

Multiplier = 8/6.4/5.33/4



### 3 of a Kind

Any 3 of

Same Rank

Multiplier = 4/3.2/2.67/2



### Two Pair

2 of Same Rank

w/other 2 Same Rank

Multiplier = 2/1.6/1.33/1



### Pair

Any 2 of

Same Rank

Multiplier = 1.5/1.2/1/0.75



### High Card

Random but

includes hole card

Multiplier = 1/0.8/0.67/0.5



**NO-TIME** In PokerSort™, if the hole card is not sorted first or if there are not exactly 5 cows or if any cows pass the gate for 5 seconds after time is called or before hand is called. In PokerPenning™, no more than 5 cows are ever allowed across the foul line.

## Tips from the Winner's Circle

### There are no bad cows...

Simply get your hole card and any other four cows to make your best (and fastest) five card poker hand.

### Be opportunistic...

and flexible in your strategy.

### Keep your eyes and ears open...

While you're hunting for a four of a kind, a faster and easier straight flush might be right on top.

### Whatever you do, do it fast...

Time is a much larger multiplier for your score.

### Think Strategically...

Your hole card must be the first cow through the gate and included in your team's hand.

### Control your herd...

In 2Man PokerSort™, exactly 5 cows must be sorted clean. After flagger calls time, no cows may pass the gate for 5 seconds or until the team's hand is called, otherwise no-time is called. In PokerPenning™, no more than 5 cows may pass the foul line at any moment. Only 5 are allowed when time is called.

### Cards are Equal...

Aces are not ranked higher than, say, 8's. In other words, the value of four aces is the same as four 8's. This is a sport of skill, not luck.
