

The Pearls for Adult CCRN Review and Certification

Introduction

Two full days of instruction provide an extensive review of physiology, critical care conditions, manifestations, diagnostics, pharmacology, and other treatment modalities. It is designed as an overall review course for those working in a critical care environment and for those nurses preparing to take the Adult CCRN Certification examination.



An extensive handout is included for use during the seminar and to reference in the future. It is presented in outline format with “bolding” of drugs, labs, assessments, and important concepts for the exam. Exam style questions will be reviewed to validate knowledge and prepare those who will be taking the test. In addition, an on-line data base of questions will be available after completion of the course. Taking a review course and doing multiple test questions enables the bedside nurse to be more confident and increases the probability of passing the exam.
