As Brett reviewed, there are three ways we can do this together. **First, pray.** Prayer is a powerful tool God has given us to connect with Him. This is a time for us to pray individually and corporately across Hendricks County and the globe, giving thanks and asking God for help and peace, the kind only He can provide. Don't overlook this chance to pray with your families, groups, and even virtually with friends over social media. **Second, give.** Kingsway is a generous people and that generosity is what fuels our mission. Your generosity is how we are able to support our six Local Outreach Partners like Sheltering Wings, Family Promise, Wheeler Mission, and Hope Healthcare; it is how we support our seven Global Outreach Partners like New Hope Children's Home in Peru, rural villages in southern India, and World Wide Hispanic Outreach in Mexico; it is how we serve and love congregation and community right here in Avon, Indiana. In this season, it is critical for the church to remain a place where people can come to find hope, through the love of Jesus Christ. Giving online through our Pushpay app is how over 70% of our people give today. **Third, serve.** When we serve others, it truly leads to life change. We have outlined four opportunities to serve today, which one do you feel moved to support?

- Community Connection is how we are reaching out to those in our community over the phone. We want to check-in with people and make sure if help is needed, we know about it and can assist.
- Pick-up and Delivery of groceries and pharmaceuticals is another option we are helping to coordinate with our local leaders and outreach partners.
- Supporting our local partners through serving meals, stocking food pantries, and providing meals is another option. This could work for individual families or possibly to pool together resources of a group you're a part of.
- Sewing CDC compliant facemasks is our fourth option. The need for facemasks continues to grow and this is a great way for some with this gift can directly support others in our community.
