Packing List: 1 Large Suitcase/ 1 Bedding Bag/ 1 Carry On Bag

Suitcase (Name, address, and phone number marked. This will go under the bus with no access while driving/stopping)

- **Clothes and Shoes** *for the week*
 - o Our dress is casual...shorts, t-shirts, flip flops, tennis shoes, etc.
 - o Students tend to want to shower and change between lunch and dinner. Free time often gets warm and sweaty!
- **Swimsuit**
 - o For Ladies: One-Piece or Two Piece – Stomach, Chest, and Rear-end must be covered.
 - o For Men: No Speedos (with the ladies leading well in this, you should too)
 - o Remember who you represent (Jesus) – Kingsway Student Team will bring some big t-shirts of shame to give to students who struggle to adhere to these rules.
- **Toiletries**
 - o Toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo & conditioner, soap, DEODORANT, hair care items, make-up, etc. (dorm style, so take to and from your room – not leaving it in the bathroom)

Bedding Bag (Large, plastic garbage bag with your name duct taped to the side in large, clear lettering.)

- **Sleeping Bag and/or bedding**, including pillow and bed sheets (twin size)
- **Towels** – one for swimming/ one for showering
- **Extra Plastic Bag** – for bedding (return trip home) and for dirty/wet clothes

Carry On Bag (Goes with you onto the bus)

- **Bible/Pen**
- **Money** – 3 meals while traveling (On-the-way, Thursday free day, Heading Home)
- **Cell Phone/ iPod/ iPad/tablet/ etc.** – Just remember 2 things... 1. All electronic (including tablets) get turned into leaders at night. 2. You are responsible for the safety and use of your device.
- **Drawstring Bag** – Normal backpacks are not allowed in the auditorium or cafeteria. Drawstring bags only

DO NOT PACK

- **Large Electronics** – No Gaming Devices (Xbox, ps4, etc.)/TV's. Please be aware that expensive devices like iPads always have a chance of being stolen or broken. Keep an eye on your belongings and lock them up in your room.
- **Weapons** – No knives, guns, blow-darts, slingshots, air soft guns, bb-guns, paintball guns, bow/arrow, sword, crossbow, switchblades, brass knuckles, fireworks, biochemicals, tanks, or thermonuclear devices, etc. (we think you get it at this point)
- **Illegal Substances** – No alcohol, tobacco of any kind, vapes, or other drugs, legal or not.

Morning Show: Make sure you are ready each morning for the Morning Show. The Morning Show is designed to wake you up each day through funny videos, stupid skits and whatever crazy ideas CIY can come up with.

Extended Recreation: This is an opportunity for you to enjoy an extended afternoon of free time. With your group, you may leave campus to check out sites in the area or enjoy the many activities available on campus.

The Affect Store: The Affect Store is a great place for you to purchase apparel, sign up for The Alternative, tournaments, group photos and more. If you don't want to bring a ton of cash, the Affect Store takes MasterCard, VISA, Amex and Discover. Be sure to know the location & posted hours of when they will be open during the week.

Encounter Time/D-Groups: Following the Morning Session, you will be dismissed to your Encounter Time and or Small Groups (D-Group). This is an opportunity for you to participate in devotions that are tied to the daily themes. You can find these devotions in your student booklet. If you have any questions, look to your leaders as they will be prepared to help you make the most of this time.

Evening Session: Evening filled with worship and dynamic speakers along with a time for decisions.

Kingsway Time: Time for our entire group to discuss the day's events at a specified location (together).

CIY MOVE - The Alternative

MOVE provides you an opportunity to share your talents (singing, instrumental, bands, skits, poetry, comedic, athletic, etc.). You may sign up for The Alternative, but do so quickly as spots are limited and fill up quickly. Come rehearsed and ready to amaze your fellow MOVE attendees!

Rules

Kingsway Adult Leaders will hold our group to these rules. Students can be sent home for not following these guidelines. CIY Move Staff and Leaders also have the right to dismiss any youth/ adult who cannot abide by these rules.

1. Respect others and yourself.
2. No guys in girl's dorms beyond the front lobby and vice versa.
3. Alcohol, tobacco, drugs and weapons are absolutely prohibited
4. Everyone must be in their dorms by the designated "In Dorm Time".
5. For security reasons, no students with backpacks are allowed into the auditorium or cafeteria.
6. Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.
7. During sessions, stay in your assigned seating. Please follow the posted seating chart.
8. Do not leave the auditorium once the speakers begin talking.
9. Respect the campus – no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc. No practical jokes!
10. Do not move furniture as you will be charged for any assessed damage.
11. Do not dial 911 unless it is a true emergency.
12. Absolutely no fireworks at any time.
13. No food deliveries of any kind to the campus.
14. Students may leave campus ONLY with adult supervision; those staying behind must have an adult present.
15. Remember who you represent, Jesus!
16. Zero Tolerance for Bullying. – The quickest way to get sent home!
