WHO DOES JESUS SAY HE IS?

The 7 I AM's of Jesus

- 1. I am the bread of life John 6:35.
- 2. I am the light of the world John 8:12.
- 3. I am the door John 10:9.
- 4. I am the good shepherd John 10:11.
- 5. I am the resurrection and the life John 11:25.
- 6. I am the way, the truth, and the life John 14:6.
- 7. I am the true vine John 15:1.

I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE – JOHN 6:35.

- 1. Jesus said this in the last year of His ministry when proving His deity.
- 2. Jesus as bread satisfies the deepest hunger by people for God. "Blessed are they who hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled" (Matt. 5:6).
- 3. Jesus as bread overcomes the curse on Adam, "In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread" (Gen.
- 3:19). The cure of Christ, "I am the living bread . . . if any man eats of this bread, he shall live" (John 6:51).
- 4. Jesus as bread brings worship to God, a type of Old Testament bread offering to the Lord. "He (the priest) took one unleavened cake . . . and left them on the altar of burnt-offering: they were consecrated for a sweet savor . . . unto the Lord" (Lev. 8:26, 28).
- 5. Jesus as bread fulfills the type of the manna in the wilderness. "Moses gave you not that bread from heaven, but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven" (John 6:32).

We need bread, we need food. Just can't survive without it. But many people have full bellies... but they are still starving inside, spiritually, so hungry perhaps they don't even know it! You see, we are more than just flesh and blood. God made us more than just that! What is fascinating is Jesus never offers a philosophy or ideology to people.... Nor does he offer just great teaching - He offers Himself - HE is the answer.

Because in the end we don't need fancy talk- we need GOD. The person of God with us now. We need Him in our lives... and we need to know He cares. And to those hungry, spiritually... those who may have everything else sorted out, but still know there is... has to be... more - He says: - "I am the bread of life." So - today we remember the physical food we have. But we remember that we need spiritual

food as well - and Jesus is that food. "I'm the bread of life. The person who believes in me will never die." (John 6:58)

I AM THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD – JOHN 8:12.

Jesus looks around at the people come to celebrate this feast and he makes his second statement – I am the Light of the World. "Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. (John 8:12) He is saying, I represent God's presence here on Earth, I am God, here on earth. And I have come to lead you out of your spiritual darkness And bring you to a place of light To free you from the blackness of sin, And illuminate your life with grace and truth."

Jesus replied, "My light will shine for you just a little longer. Walk in the light while you can, so the darkness will not overtake you. Those who walk in the darkness cannot see where they are going. Put your trust in the light while there is still time; then you will become children of the light." John 12:35-36

"Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God. Let there be no sexual immorality, impurity, or greed among you. Such sins have no place among God's people. Obscene stories, foolish talk, and coarse jokes—these are not for you. Instead, let there be thankfulness to God. You can be sure that no immoral, impure, or greedy person will inherit the Kingdom of Christ and of God. For a greedy person is an idolater, worshiping the things of this world. Don't be fooled by those who try to excuse these sins, for the anger of God will fall on all who disobey him. Don't participate in the things these people do. For once you were full of darkness, but now you have light from the Lord. So live as people of light! For this light within you produces only what is good and right and true." (Ephesians 5:1-9)

The Bible says that God is light. Intellectually that means the knowledge of God is light. Morally that means the holiness of God is light. Physically that means the glory of God is light. When Jesus says that we are the light of the world, it means God has deposited His nature inside of us, and we are to let it out. It's in there! It just needs to be allowed to shine forth. Christian, you aren't the only person ever called 'the light of the world.' Who else? Yes, other Christians, but who else? Jesus! So, Christ is in us, and we aren't really, in and of ourselves, the light, but the light is in us!

The Putting Out of the Light

Q. What bushels do we allow to snuff out our lights?

Probably dozens, but here's a couple: one applies to your walk, and the other to your talk.

Worldliness—unwillingness to be different, to be salt or light. We don't wanna be laughed at or thought of as strange...so, we follow the course of the world, and go with the flow, instead of heading upstream...taking a stand. That worldly attitude is a bushel that will snuff out your light.

Our talk: And fear is the bushel we allow to snuff out our witnessing opportunities. Let's take a survey and be honest and show how many of us have had open doors to witness, and even been prompted to by God's Spirit, but have caved in to fear. All of us!

The Purpose of the Light

Why do we do good works? So people will remark what a great Christian you are? No! The purpose of the light is not to glorify itself. You don't turn a light on to draw attention to the light, but to whatever it is shining on. The purpose of the light is to illuminate Jesus and to glorify the Father in heaven! The 'city set on a hill' is a collective term, indicating the church. We are to be a lighthouse on a hillside that overlooks a storm-tossed sea.

The Many Styles of Lights

- **The CHRISTMAS "Lights" Christians....... Used only one time a year, Used only on a special occasion. These are More For Show than anything else. Some Christians come once a year or on Special Occasions.
- **The FLASHING "Lights" Christians.......These are On & Off On & Off On & Off. These have No Consistency. These Christians can't be counted on to get the job done.
