“Lord, to whom shall we go?” – **John 6:68**

We are going to camp in John 6 for most of our lesson today...

Read the following verses:

John 6: 1-2

John 6: 12

John 6: 16-21

John 6: 25-27

What are they? What makes them hard?

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How do you deal with those hard teachings?

Read John 6: 66-68

“The words of eternal life... the Holy One of God.”

Why do you suppose they turned back?

Have you ever considered turning back?

Has anything ever challenged your faith enough to cause you to doubt or think about turning back?

Do you think it's OK to have doubts? Questions? Concerns or fears?

How do we help those that have turned back, or turned away to see the real Jesus?

With Easter fast approaching, how will we help others to see the real Jesus?
