Revelation 19:1-10

Read Revelation 18

- What are some key points to how the world reacted to the Fall of Babylon the Great?
- Why were the people sad?
 - What was the source of their joy in Babylon prior to its fall?

Read Revelation 19:1-10

Verses 19:1-3

- What is the source of Joy for the Church?
 - How would this scene have impacted the Roman church (the first audience of this book).
 - How would it speak to persecuted church around the world now?
 - What about Churches in freer parts of the world like the USA?
- How is that source similar to that of the world in chapter 18?
 - How does this help us understand the world outside the church?
- How is that source different?
 - How does this help us share the good news of Jesus?

Verses 19:4

- Why is it important that the elders not only worshipped God, but did so from their knees?
 - What does this posture symbolize?
 - Does it have implications for how we worship and lead?

Verses 19:5-7

- What drives the people of God to worship?
 - Are they the same or different than what drives us to worship now?
- What makes large corporate worship different from personal reflection?
 - Why are both needed?

Verses 19:8-9

- How is the church blessed by the wedding, specifically in light of the previous 18 chapters?

Verses 19:10

- How are tempted to worship the created rather than the creator, even in light of the miraculous? After all, John had just witnessed the great works of God, and still made a mistake here.
