The data given in the question is used to write a bio-sketch or personally compiled by the writer. What is a biographical sketch? bio-sketch or biographical sketch is a brief write that summarize a person's life, achievements, character, experience, etc. This is a short description highlighting the main features of the personality of the chosen subject. How to write a biographical sketch? Biography sketch: It is always written by a person other than the one who is described. The aim of the bio-sketch is large to present a positive image of the person concerned. It is advisable to present all information in chronological order when writing a bio-sketch so that the reader can monitor the life of the subject from beginning to end. Biographical Sketch Format for Students The main points that need to be incorporated when writing a bio-sketch are: Full name, date of birth/ age, place of birth Main personality features Educational data highlighting all significant achievements or appreciation of His/Her contribution to society Any particular interest Why is he/she famous or well known? The biographical sketch is always written in the third person and aims to describe significant achievements or impressive features of a person's personality. Before writing a bio-sketch, the writer must conduct thorough research on the life of the subject he/she chose. This can be done by reading reliable information in magazines, books, libraries, or an online database. The writer can then prepare the timeline of a person's life and decide which points he wants to emphasize. Since the bio-sketch is a brief description, it describes such features, events, and achievements. In short, the writer should be able to paint a pen portrait of the subject and convince the reader that the person was unique and worth reading. This would include information on a person's name, place of residence, education, occupation, life and activities and other important details. A biographical sketch is always written by someone else except the person on which it is written. Provides a pen image of this person. The bio-sketch presents facts about a person's life, including what a person did and how he/she influenced the world. It should describe a person's personality and provide an explanation of why they acted in a certain way. Most bio-sketches not only present facts, but also tell you what these facts mean.
