
Get Started:

- If your student already has a Kiddom account, you're one step ahead! Simply login using your student's Kiddom credentials.
- If your student does not have an account, sign up with a user name or email address at www.kiddom.co
- The student's Class Code will be needed from their teacher to join.
- A notification will be sent to the teacher to approve the request to join the class.
- Does your student have multiple classes? Click "Join Class" on the student dashboard and add the Class Code for each of their classes.

Support Your Student:

- View which assignments are completed and which are past due on your student's Timeline. Switch to Reports to view progress in skill performance over time.
