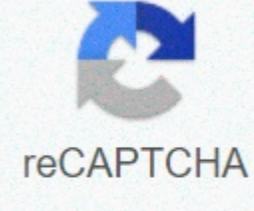

## 2012 chevrolet traverse owners manual

The Traverse has a large 3.6-litre V-6 turbomotor. Estimated fuel economy totals 27 MPG. The car has a four-cylinder engine that can be upgraded to a 2.0-liter engine with a V-6 transmission for a power boost. The Chevrolet Traverse has a lot of common problems with most models. A transmission failure can be developed and the verification engine light can be turned on. This may be due to several reasons highlighted in the owner's manual. The parking brake can also be disconnected without warning on the Traverse while the car is parked and this can pose a great danger to the car if it is tilted. The camshaft sensor may run out after a while and may not even be fixed after replacing it. This is due to a distribution chain issue within the Chevrolet Traverse. While these problems may seem serious, some DIY repairs can help resolve them in no time. The Chevrolet Traverse is a mid-sized seven- or eight-seat crossover SUV built by General Motors. It is based on the same platform as GMC Acadia and Buick Enclave (Lambda for first generation, C1XX for second generation). It is the successor to the Chevrolet Trailblazer SUV and Uplander minivan. Originally marketed as a full-size crossover SUV, the Traverse was built at GM's assembly plant in Spring Hill, Tennessee, during 2009, but then production of the Traverse had moved to the GM Delta Township, Michigan assembly plant in 2010. The 2009 Chevrolet Traverse debuted at the 2008 Chicago Auto Show and the Traverse had reached all Chevrolet dealerships in October 2008. The second generation model debuted in showrooms in the summer of 2017. Starting with the 2019 model year, the Traverse was slotted above the new mid-sized Chevrolet Blazer as part of Chevrolet's plans to expand its CUV line.
