So far, we have covered the process of – surveying, analyzing, and synthesizing the scripture we wish to study. Having covered each of these steps the bible student should have a decent understanding of the text. At this point we should be able to answer some of the original questions we may have hade and ultimately be able to discuss what the text meant for the direct audience it was written to when it was written to them. This brings us to one of the last steps – reflection.

Reflection is when the bible student asks the question "so, what does this mean to/for me?" Sometimes a verse is written to a specific person or group and therefor may not apply to a modern Christian the same way it did in the first century. Consider Philippians 4:2,3. These two verses were written to two specific women as well as the congregation they were apart of. These verses do not directly apply to the modern question. However, that does not mean we can not glean something from it and find application for ourselves. In this example it seems as if these two women had some sort of conflict between them that they needed to overcome for the sake of the gospel. The application we can infer is that we need to put our own quarrels away and be of the same mind in the Lord with our own church family.

This step, while done specifically towards the end, is one we should be thinking about through the process of our study. Understanding what the Bible says is important. Understand what it means for us is crucial.
