Friends of Montgomery Mill

Montgomery Mill once proudly stood on the banks of Pitman Creek about 2½ miles Northeast of Greensburg at the “Narrows” near the Cumberland Trace and Pitman Station. Milling activities date back to the 1790’s at this location.

Dr. Nimrod H. Arnold is credited with cutting a narrow channel in the bedrock at the “Narrows” in 1826 that served as the millrace for Montgomery Mill. An upstream mill dam was also constructed to direct the water into the channel and through a turbine. Power from the turbine was then transferred by a cable/pulley system up to the mill’s main driveshaft which was located several yards away. This system provided sufficient power to turn the millstone and operate the mill.

David Montgomery purchased the mill in 1848 and the mill was operated predominately by the Montgomery family until sometime after J. T. Montgomery died in 1928.

Montgomery Mill earned a place of honor as a historically significant site when it was placed on the National Register in 1984 following an application submitted by Joe DeSpain, Green County Historical Society.
