## Please read and detach before returning Driver Authorization form:

- To ensure all children, youth and vulnerable adults are safely transported to and from church-sponsored activities that require volunteer drivers, St. Sanctuary requires that all drivers complete this **Driver Authorization Form**, and attach proof of insurance and a copy of a valid driver's license. This form will be updated as needed.
- By signing the form, the driver attests that the information is accurate and that she or he:
  - Is in good health and capable of operating their vehicle in a safe manner
  - Keeps his/her vehicle in safe working order
  - Makes sure every individual wears safety belt during transport.
  - Will not hold the church responsible for damages to his/her vehicle
  - Has a minimum driving experience of three years
  - Meets the "safe driver" qualifications of no more than one moving violation in the last three years and no more than one at fault accident in five years.
- The limits of the driver's automobile **insurance coverage** must fall within the recommendations of our insurance carrier.
- Drivers must be 25 or older.
- While St. Sanctuary's policy requires two adults be present with youth, a solo adult driver is acceptable as long as there are two or more youth in the car. Any exception to this requires a waiver signed by the youth's parents. For example, for a single youth to travel alone with a pastor or youth director, the youth's parent must sign a waiver.
- To respond quickly in the event of an emergency, the driver should have a copy of every passenger's **Medical Release Form** in the car when driving for the church. On trips when passengers may change cars, it's recommended that the drivers have this information for every youth or child who is attending the event.
- The original volunteer must get a substitute driver any time when an ability of the volunteer is impaired in any way by alcohol, substance, or emotional condition, physical ability or health condition.
- Authorized drivers' policy applies to transportation to and from the point of origin. Getting to and from the point of origin is outside of the policy.
