In the Beginning: Science and Genesis 1-11—Rich Akin—Room W-11

Atheists now falsely proclaim to the public that science disproves the existence of God and missiologists indicate the “theory” of evolution has become one of the greatest barriers to the Gospel. As we walk through portions of the first 11 chapters of Genesis, this course demonstrates in an easy to understand manner that science rightly viewed is in fact in concert with the clear teachings of the creation and catastrophe events set forth there. In these days when many have a seriously deficient understanding of who is God and what He is like, are you ready to “...contend earnestly for the faith once for all handed down to the saints”? One of the primary missions of the Elders of Lakeside is to equip the church with an in depth understanding of the vital doctrines of the Christian faith. One avenue to accomplish this goal is through a series of deep yet relevant and accessible classes in systematic theology. This fall the first of these classes will be taught on the doctrines of God. Who is God? What is He like? What is the Trinity? Is God sovereign? These doctrines form the foundation of every Christian’s ability to understand the Bible. This class will call upon you to study these truths, develop your understanding of them, and put down in writing what you believe so that you can build on these truths in future classes. We will be using Wayne Grudem’s book on systematic theology in this class.
