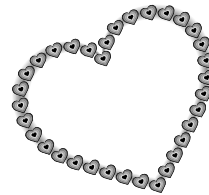
CHRISTMAS IN OCTOBER

Remember Jesus said “It is more blessed to give than to receive,” (Acts 20:35) and Merry Christmas!

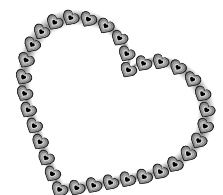
