## Christmas in October

In our evening service, Joe Aleppo will be sharing with us about his work with Aurora. 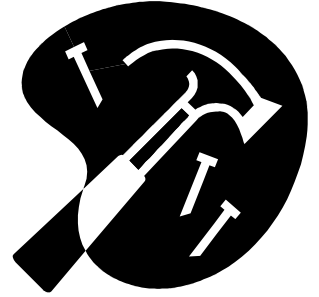
