**“Isaiah: God Saves Sinners”** (by Raymond C. Orlund, Jr., R. Kent Hughes) **Part 1** (Part 2 will be offered in January)  
Isaiah is widely considered the deepest, richest, and most theologically significant book in the Old Testament. It is, without question, a profound statement by God about His own sovereignty and majesty spoken through His chosen spokesman, the prophet Isaiah. *RIGG WHITE—ROOM W-9—Coed*

**“An Inductive Study of Ephesians”** (class questions provided in class) In this class, we will use an inductive Bible study method in order to systematically analyze and interpret the original intent of Ephesians. The emphasis in this class will be on breaking down the flow of teaching used by the author in order to understand the overall and subordinate themes of Ephesians.
