## SECOND QUARTER FINANCIAL UPDATE—October 1, 2014 – December, 31 2014

In the interest of continuing to provide greater information to our congregation about our financial standing, the elders would like to provide a financial update for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter for our current fiscal year (July 2014 – June 2015). This update covers the months of October through December. The goal is for you as our congregation to be better informed of our financial position, so that you can be in prayer with us for the overall financial health of our various ministries.

As was reported at end of the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of the fiscal year, our giving year started out in negative territory, even though it was an improvement over the prior year giving for the same time period. After 3 months, the weekly giving had not kept pace with our budget, and we had a general fund giving deficit at the end of September of \$19,441. This was a serious concern, as our general fund giving is what we use for the day to day operation of our ministries. As an elder board we asked for your prayers and encouraged our church body to respond to the financial needs of the ministry.

We are humbled and pleased to report to you that God has heard our collective prayers and has truly blessed Lakeside through the generous giving of our church family in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of the year. Our weekly general fund giving average for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter was \$25,416, which was a substantial increase over the \$22,008 giving average in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter. Accordingly the \$19,441 deficit we had at the end of September was completely eliminated, and we ended December with a budget surplus of \$5,471.\*

In addition to the gracious turnaround in our weekly giving, Lakeside also received during the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter the last installment of the estate gift that was designated for our church by our beloved brother Harry Nichols. This has allowed us to add additional funds, as previously planned, to our church's strategic reserve account, and also provides us with a substantial cash reserve which is available for further investment in the Lord's work.

Even as we rejoice over what the Lord has done in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter through the giving of His faithful saints, we ask for your continued prayers and support for the rest of our fiscal year. Your generosity allows us to carry out the ministry that we believe God has called us to, both here and through our missionaries around the globe. Thank you for your continued financial faithfulness to Lakeside.

If you would like additional information about the financial condition at Lakeside, you can receive a copy of the more detailed financial reports for this fiscal year, which are prepared on a monthly basis. \* This positive giving trend continued in January 2015, such that we ended January with a general fund giving surplus of \$11,018.
