Observe

- 4. What is happening in this image? Students and the teacher have their heads bowed in prayer.
- 5. What is significant about the date this photo was taken?

- This photo was taken on June 27, 1962 which was two days after the decision in *Engel v. Vitale*. This shows that some classes/schools continued to pray even after the decision that teacher led prayer was unconstitutional.
- 6. If someone took this photo today, what would be different? What would be the same? Student answers will vary but may include that students would not be praying, styles of dress would be different and likely less formal, hair styles would be different, classes may not be arranged in rows, or that there would be technology in the classroom such as laptops, Smart boards, etc.
