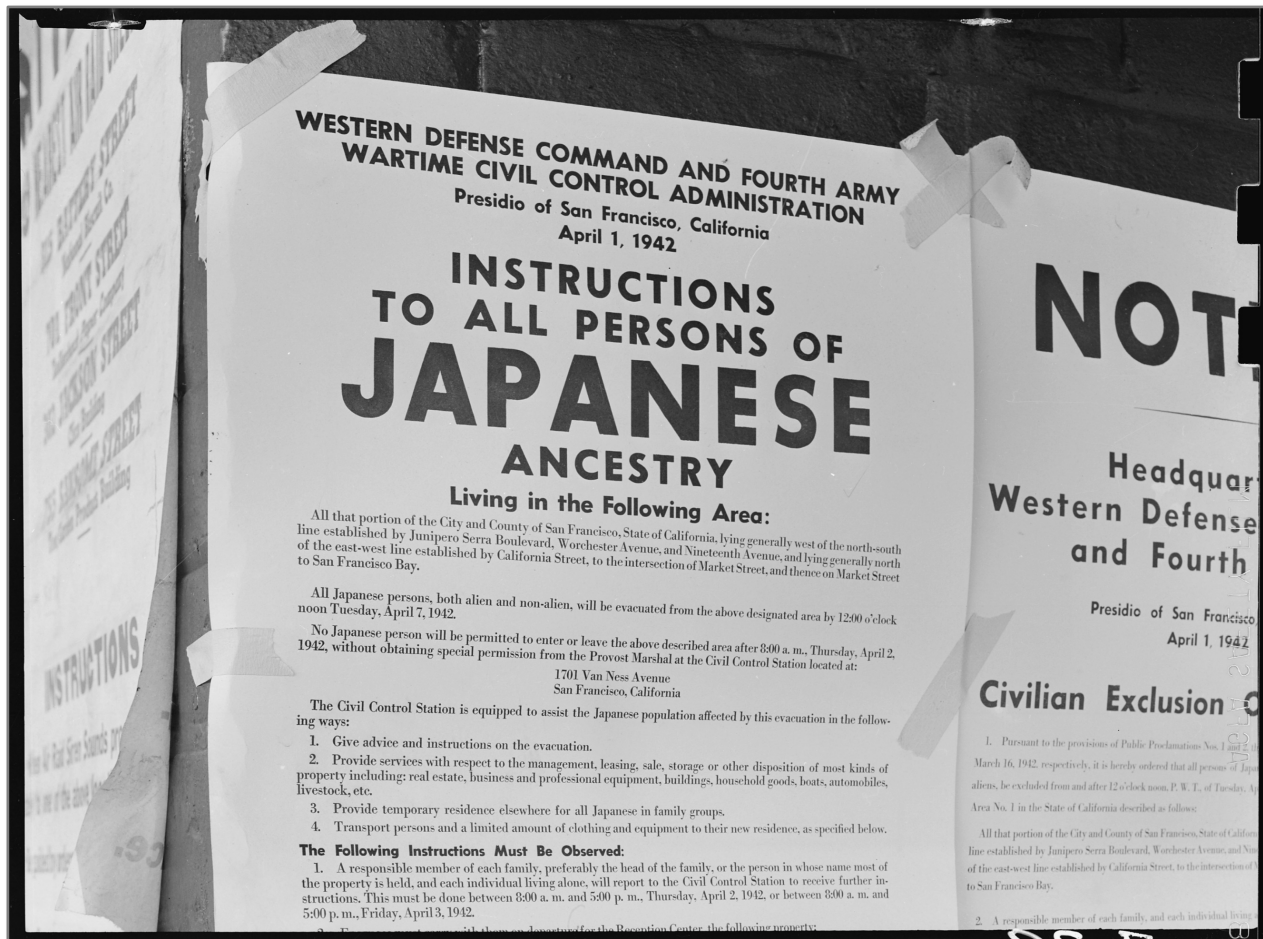


Korematsu v. United States / Primary Source Analysis
