- 5. From studying the tables, what conclusions can be drawn regarding American political opinion on the issue of the Constitutional amendment to protect the flag?
- 6. What would account for the differences in results in Question 2 and Question 3?
- 7. Why do some people believe that even speech that is unpopular needs to be protected?

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
