SOLU-CAL 6-12-6 may be applied to a wide variety of turf grasses & newly seeded turf areas.

- **FOR NEWLY SEEDED & SODDED AREAS:** Coverage 10,000sq.ft. Apply 5 lbs per 1000 sq. ft or 220 lbs per acre at time of seeding. For best results, re-apply 4-6 weeks after initial application at the same rate. *Water in thoroughly*
- **FOR EXISTING TURF:** 6-12-6 Can be used to properly maintain nutrient levels at the same rates for new seeding as needed throughout the season. *Water in thoroughly.*

SOLU-CAL 6-12-6 used as directed will supplement your fertilizer program by providing .3 lbs Nitrogen, .3 lbs Potassium, .6 lbs Phosphorous and .85 lbs Ca. per 1000 sq ft. with each application. It is ideal for all turf types.
