## The 4 Essential Auxiliaries: Must, Want, Can't & Going To

<b>I must</b> eat.	<b>Je dois</b> manger.	Literally, "I must to eat".
<b>I want to</b> eat.	<b>Je veux</b> manger.	Literally, "I want to eat".
<b>I can't</b> eat.	<b>Je ne peux pas</b> manger.	Literally, "I no can to eat".
<b>I am going to</b> eat tomorrow.	<b>Je vais</b> manger <b>demain</b> .	Literally, "I go to eat tomorrow".
