

Summary of Post-ECQ Requirements and Period of Submission

<p>i. A Foreign National whose VISA expired during the ECQ period</p>	<p>Tourist VISA Extension:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Photocopy of the passport biopage and latest admission with valid authorized stay • Duly accomplished VISA Extension Form • Sworn Statement for overstaying/updating of stay or more than six (6) months <p>Extension of Pre-Arranged Employee-Commercial under Section 9(G)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Duly accomplished Consolidated General Application Form • Photocopy of the passport biopage and latest admission with valid authorized stay • Photocopy of the renewed Employment Contract, indicating exact compensation, duration of employment and comprehensive description of the position • Photocopy of the General Information Sheet stamped received by the Securities and Exchange Commission • Photocopy of Alien Employment Permit • Bureau of Immigration Clearance Certificate 	<p>Applications for extension should be filed within thirty (30) days from the lifting of the ECQ.</p> <p>Example: A foreign national's tourist VISA expired on 15 April 2020 (during the ECQ period), and the ECQ is lifted on 30 April 2020. He/she must file an application for extension on or before 30 May 2020 (30 days after the ECQ is lifted).</p>

<p>ii. A Foreign National who departed the country without his/her Alien Certificate of Registration Card ("ACR I-Card") enters the country after the ECQ period</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport with valid visa, as indicated in the implementation stamp; and • Official receipts of the ACR I-Card Waiver Application Fee and Immigration Clearance Certificate ("ECC") with Returning Permit or Special Resident Certificate, whichever is applicable. 	<p>Requirements must be presented upon entry of the country.</p> <p>Example: A foreign national who departed the country on 15 April 2020 (during the ECQ period) without an ACR I-Card will return to the Philippines on 04 May 2020 (after the ECQ is lifted), he must present the documentary requirements upon his arrival.</p>
<p>iii. A Foreign National who departed the country without having his/her VISA implemented on his/her passport enters the country after the ECQ period</p>	<p>Revalidation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Letter request addressed to the Commissioner, stating the reason why he/she left the country prior or after the approval of his/her visa, with no derogatory stamp from the Certification and Clearance Section • Affidavit of Explanation, if the applicant failed to file the request for revalidation within fifteen (15) days from latest arrival • Photocopy of supporting documents to substantiate the reason for leaving the country prior to or after the approval of his/her visa • Photocopy of his/her passport bio-page, latest departure and arrival stamps 	<p>Revalidation should be applied immediately upon the Foreign National's arrival.</p> <p>Example: If a Foreign National departed the Philippines on 15 April 2020 (during the ECQ period) without having his/her VISA implemented on his/her passport enters the country on 04 May 2020 (after the ECQ is lifted), he/she must immediately proceed to the main office of the Bureau of Immigration to apply for Revalidation.</p>
