
# Changes in Appearance...


Many investigators agree that changes in work routine including a new job, recent layoff, or a sudden need to work late regularly can be indicators of infidelity.

WHEN SOMEONE SUSPECTS INFIDELITY IN A RELATIONSHIP IT CAN BE DIFFICULT TO DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT THOSE SUSPICIONS ARE VALID- AND IF SO, WHAT TO DO NEXT

### Married People Who Cheat:



Breakdown of which spouse cheated when infidelity occurred

Anywhere between

30%=60%

of married people cheat



Statistics vary due to an unwillingness to admit infidelity in studies

#### Is Your Intuition Correct?

Wives who suspect their husbands of cheating are correct 85% of the time





Husbands who suspect their wives of cheating are correct only 50% of the time

### Who Would Cheat?



Say that they would cheat if they knew they wouldn't get caught.

# Average Cost



Is the average cost of investigating an infidelity case. Prices were listed as low as \$500 and as high as \$5,500

# Length of Investigation



Our survey revealed that an infidelity investigation can last anywhere from just a few hours to over 6 months

#### Success Rates?



62% of the investigators we surveyed say that infidelity is confirmed in over 75% of cases
