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ON 01/26/11 AT ABOUT 1408 HOURS DAN GUKEISEN ASSAULTED JOHN TAVERNARO WITH A HANDGUN ON THE FRONT PATIO OF GUKEISEN'S RESIDENCE LOCATED AT 1119 E RIVIERA DR, TEMPE AZ.

TAVERNARO CONTACTED GUKEISEN AND HIS WIFE KIM RICHTER IN THEIR FRONT YARD AT THEIR RESIDENCE ATTEMPTING TO SERVE GUKEISEN WITH CIVIL PROCESS DOCUMENTS FROM A BANKRUPTCY COURT IN TUCSON AZ.

GUKEISEN ACCUSED TAVERNARO OF TRESPASSING AND TOLD HIM HE HAD TO LEAVE. TAVERNARO SERVED GUKEISEN WITH THE COURT DOCUMENTS. GUKEISEN WENT INTO HIS RESIDENCE AND CAME OUT WITH A GUN, PUTTING THE GUN TO TAVERNARO'S NECK.

GUKEISEN ALLOWED TAVERNARO TO LEAVE A SHORT TIME LATER AND WENT BACK INTO HIS RESIDENCE. TAVERNARO CALLED POLICE AND WAITED FOR POLICE TO ARRIVE AT 1119 E RIVIERA.

DIGITAL PICTURES WERE TAKEN OF GUKEISEN'S FRONT YARD, TRESPASSING SIGNS AND GATE FOR HIS DRIVEWAY. DIGITAL PICTURES WERE ALSO TAKEN OF TAVERNARO'S NECK AND ARMS WHERE HE HAD MINOR INJURIES. A DIGITAL RECORDING WAS MADE OF TAVERNARO'S STATEMENT. THE FLASH CARD WITH PICTURES AND THE CD MADE FROM THE DIGITAL RECORDING WERE IMPOUNDED AS EVIDENCE ON A CD AT 8201 S HARDY.

GUKEISEN WAS NOT LOCATED FOR HIS STORY. * PENDING *

ON 01/26/11 AT 1410 HOURS I WAS DISPATCHED TO 1119 E RIVIERA IN REFERENCE TO A REPORTED CRIMINAL TRESPASS BY A PROCESS SERVER NAMED JOHN TAVERNARO. TAVERNARO CALLED LATER TO REPORT THE ASSAULT ON HIM. COMMENTS ON THE CALL RELATED THERE WAS A SUBJECT WITH A GUN. THE SUBJECT ALLEGEDLY USED THE GUN AND HELD IT TO THE PROCESS SERVER'S NECK. THE PROCESS SERVER WAS IDENTIFIED IN THE CALL FOR SERVICE AS JOHN TAVERNARO. KIM RICHTER WAS THE ORIGINAL CALLER. SHE ALSO ADVISED SHE HAD DETAINED THE SUBJECT THAT HAD TRESPASSED ON HER PROPERTY.

WHEN I ARRIVED AT NEWBERRY AND RIVIERA I STOPPED SHORT OF THE SCENE AND OBSERVED AN OLDER WHITE MALE LATER IDENTIFIED AS JOHN TAVERNARO. TAVERNARO WAS STANDING IN FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE AT 1119 E RIVIERA. I COULD SEE NUMEROUS NO TRESPASSING SIGNS IN ENGLISH AND SPANISH. THERE WAS A CLOSED GATE ACROSS THE DRIVEWAY AND ANOTHER PEDESTRIAN GATE TO ITS EAST ON THE PROPERTY OF 1119 E RIVIERA. ALL THE GATES WERE CLOSED.

I WAVED TO TAVERNARO TO COME TO ME. I REMAINED AT MY VEHICLE AND TAVERNARO WALKED TOWARDS ME. WHEN HE ARRIVED HE IDENTIFIED HIMSELF TO ME AS A CIVIL PROCESS SERVER FOR THE SUPERIOR COURT. HE WAS CURRENTLY SERVING DOCUMENTS ON DAN GUKEISEN AND HIS WIFE KIM RICHTER.

OFFICERS SET A PERIMETER AROUND THE RESIDENCE. I SPOKE TO TAVERNARO REGARDING THE INCIDENT. TAVERNARO TOLD ME THE FOLLOWING. HE HAD PAPERWORK TO SERVE BOTH KIM RICHTER AND DAN GUKEISEN. BOTH GUKEISEN AND RICHTER KNOW TAVERNARO AND HAVE HAD CONTACT IN THE PAST WITH SOME OTHER SERVICE ISSUES. TAVERNARO TOLD ME HE HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN IN CONTACT WITH BOTH SUBJECTS AND BEEN ACCUSED OF CRIMINAL TRESPASS FOR GOING ONTO GUKEISEN'S PROPERTY ATTEMPTING TO SERVE HIM ON 09/22/10. KIM RICHTER HAD ASSAULTED HIM AND BEEN ARRESTED BY TEMPE POLICE OFFICERS. HE TOLD ME THE CITY ATTORNEY FOR TEMPE HAD DROPPED THE CASE WHEN TAVERNARO DROPPED CHARGES ON RICHTER AND TOLD GUKEISEN TAVERNARO WAS LAWFULLY ON HIS PROPERTY TO SERVE CIVIL PROCESS. TAVERNARO COULD NOT TELL ME THE REPORT NUMBER.

I ASKED TAVERNARO TO TELL ME WHAT HAD HAPPENED. HE TOLD ME THE FOLLOWING. HE HAD GONE TO THE RESIDENCE AND KNOCKED ON THE DOOR TO THE RESIDENCE BUT HAD HEARD NOTHING AND RECEIVED NO ANSWER. HE RETURNED TO HIS VEHICLE, A SILVER COLORED CHEVY HHR. HE WAS PARKED A SHORT DISTANCE EAST OF GUKEISEN'S RESIDENCE. HE WAITED ABOUT 45 MINUTES AND HE OBSERVED GUKEISEN AND RICHTER DRIVE UP IN A SMALL WHITE COLORED PICK UP TRUCK. HE RECOGNIZED THEM FROM PREVIOUS CONTACT AND APPROACHED THEM TO SERVE THEM WITH BANKRUPTCY DOCUMENTS.

TAVERNARO WALKED TOWARDS GUKEISEN AND ENTERED ONTO GUKEISEN'S PROPERTY, WALKING UP THE DRIVEWAY. GUKEISEN TURNED AND RECOGNIZED TAVERNARO. GUKEISEN TOLD TAVERNARO HE WAS TRESPASSING. HE TOLD HIM TO "GET OFF". TAVERNARO TOLD GUKEISEN HE HAD A LEGAL RIGHT TO BE ON HIS PROPERTY AND HE HAD BEEN TOLD THAT. TAVERNARO WAS REFERRING TO THE CITY PROSECUTOR TELLING GUKEISEN TAVERNARO HAD A RIGHT TO SERVE THE CIVIL PROCESS.

GUKEISEN TOLD TAVERNARO A SECOND TIME TO GET OFF HIS PROPERTY AND STARTED TO WALK INTO HIS RESIDENCE. TAVERNARO APPROACHED HIM WITH THE INTENT

TO GIVE HIM THE COURT DOCUMENTS. TAVERNARO PUT THE PAPERS ON DOOR STEP WHEN GUKEISEN CAME THROUGH THE FRONT DOOR OF THE RESIDENCE WITH A GUN TAVERNARO DESCRIBED ONLY AS A 9MM HANDGUN.

GUKEISEN GRABBED TAVERNARO BY THE ARM. GUKEISEN TOOK TAVERNARO BY THE ARM AND PUSHED HIM OVER A LOW PATIO WALL TELLING HIM TO GET DOWN. GUKEISEN PRESSED THE GUN INTO THE LEFT SIDE OF TAVERNARO'S NECK BEHIND HIS LEFT EAR AND TOLD HIM HE HAD ALREADY TOLD HIM TO GET DOWN. TAVERNARO WAS FORCED DOWN OVER THE WALL BY GUKEISEN'S ACTIONS.

GUKEISEN TOLD TAVERNARO HE HAD ALREADY WARNED HIM FOR TRESPASSING AND HE WOULD NOW HAVE TO SUFFER THE CONSEQUENCES. TAVERNARO REMINDED GUKEISEN HE WAS AN OFFICER OF THE COURT AND GUKEISEN KEPT HIM THERE IN THE POSITION OVER THE WALL FOR BETWEEN 30 SEC TO TWO MINUTES. TAVERNARO COULD NOT BE SURE HOW MUCH TIME HE HAD BEEN THERE IN THAT POSITION.

TAVERNARO TOLD ME EVENTUALLY KIM RICHTER HAD COME OUT FROM THE RESIDENCE AND CALLED 911 FOR POLICE. HE HEARD RICHTER SPEAKING TO THE 911 OPERATOR SAYING THEY WERE HOLDING TAVERNARO FOR POLICE AND THEY HAD TAVERNARO PREVIOUSLY ARRESTED FOR TRESPASSING. SHE HAD SAID THE CITY OF TEMPE HAD REFUSED TO PROSECUTE AND THIS TIME SHE WISHED TO HAVE TAVERNARO PROSECUTED.

TAVERNARO SPOKE TO GUKEISEN TELLING HIM HE WAS IN BIG TROUBLE, THAT HE HAD ATTACKED AN OFFICER OF THE SUPERIOR COURT. GUKEISEN THOUGHT ABOUT IT FOR A MOMENT AND TOLD TAVERNARO HE WAS GOING TO REMOVE THE GUN AND TAVERNARO WAS GOING TO LEAVE. TAVERNARO TOLD HIM HE WAS STAYING TO TALK TO POLICE.

GUKEISEN REMOVED THE GUN FROM HIS NECK. RICHTER CONTINUED YELLING AND GUKEISEN YELLED AT HIS WIFE TO COME INTO THE RESIDENCE. RICHTER WENT INTO THE RESIDENCE RETURNED AND THREW THE DOCUMENTS TAVERNARO HAD SERVED. SHE WENT OT HER VEHICLE AND LEFT THE SCENE.

TAVERNARO NEVER SAW GUKEISEN LEAVE THE RESIDENCE. HE STATED GUKEISEN WAS LIKELY STILL IN THE RESIDENCE.

A PERIMETER WAS HELD AROUND THE RESIDENCE FOR SOME TIME AND ATTEMPT TO CONTACT PERSONS INSIDE THE RESIDENCE MADE. A FEMALE CALLED TEMPE POLICE DISPATCH AFTER OFFICERS TRIED TO CONTACT OCCUPANTS. EVENTUALLY TWO FEMALES AND TWO SMALL CHILDREN EXITED THE RESIDENCE AND WERE CONTACTED BY OFFICER'S P. MORRIS #11726 AND J. CAMILIERE #11435. OFFICER MORRIS CONTACTED SUSAN STUART AND OFFICER CAMILIERE CONTACTED MARGARET CARROL AND TWO CHILDREN. FOR DETAILS REGARDING STATEMENTS MADE SEE THEIR SUPPLEMENTS TO THIS REPORT.

OFFICER'S MORRIS AND CAMILIERE ADVISED BOTH WOMEN SAID DAN GUKEISEN HAD LEFT WITH HIS WIFE AND WAS NOT INSIDE THE RESIDENCE. NO SEARCH WAS CONDUCTED OF THE RESIDENCE AND CHARGES WERE FILED PENDING ON GUKEISEN PER THE CITY ATTORNEY.

STUART AND CARROL WERE ALLOWED BACK INTO THE RESIDENCE AND POLICE CLEARED THE SCENE.

I TOOK DIGITAL PICTURES OF INJURIES TO JOHN TAVERNARO. HE HAD A MINOR ABRASION TO HIS RIGHT ELBOW. HE TOLD ME THAT HAD MOST LIKELY OCCURRED WHEN

ON 01/26/11 AT 1413 HRS., I WAS DISPATCHED TO 1119 E. RIVIERA DR. TEMPE IN REGARDS TO A TRESPASSING AND A SUBJECT WITH A GUN. UPON MY ARRIVAL I TOOK A PERIMETER/TRAFFIC POST APPROX. 4 HOUSES WEST FROM 1119 E. RIVIERA DR.

TWO W/F FEMALE SUBJECTS WITH TWO CHILDREN EXITED 1119 E. RIVIERA DR. AND WERE ESCORTED TO MY POST BY OFFICER MORRIS, I INTERVIEWED ONE OF THE W/F SUBJECTS WHO IDENTIFIED HERSELF AS MARGARET HELEN CARROLL.

CARROLL TOLD ME THAT AN UNKNOWN MALE SUBJECT WAS RINGING THE DOOR BELL. THE OTHER FEMALE SUBJECT NAMED SUSAN STEWART, WHO WAS WITH CARROLL, TOLD CARROLL NOT TO ANSWER THE DOOR BECAUSE SHE DID NOT KNOW WHO IT WAS.

AT APPROX. 1400 HRS., KIM RICHTER AND DAN GUKISEN CAME HOME. CARROLL COULD HEAR SOME ONE YELLING, "GET OFF OF MY PROPERTY. I'M CALLING THE POLICE." CARROLL ALSO HEARD A MALE VOICE SAY SOMETHING TO THE EFFECT, "YOU'VE BEEN SERVED."

CARROLL TOLD ME THAT SHE COULD NOT SEE WHAT WAS GOING ON OUTSIDE BECAUSE OF THE WAY THE WINDOWS WERE COVERED UP.

CARROLL TOLD ME THAT BOTH RICHTER AND GUKISEN THEN CAME INTO THEIR HOME. GUKISEN WENT INTO THE CLOSET BY THE FRONT DOOR AND APPEARED TO BE LOOKING FOR SOMETHING ON THE TOP SHELF. CARROLL TOLD ME THAT GUKISEN HAD KNOCKED ITEMS FROM THE TOP SHELF ONTO THE FLOOR. GUKISEN LEFT THE ITEMS ON THE FLOOR AND THEN WENT TO THE BEDROOM WITH RICHTER. A FEW MINUTES LATER BOTH GUKISEN AND RICHTER CAME OUT OF THE BEDROOM AND WALKED OUT THE DOOR. JUST BEFORE LEAVING RICHTER TOLD CARROLL AND STEWART TO LOCK THE DOOR.

CARROLL TOLD ME THAT SHE DID NOT KNOW WHERE GUKISEN AND RICHTER WENT TO, OR WHEN THEY WOULD BE BACK.

I ASKED CARROLL IF SHE SAW ANY ITEMS IN GUKISEN'S HAND WHEN HE ENTERED THE HOUSE OR WHEN HE EXITED THE HOUSE. CARROLL TOLD ME THAT THEY CAME IN AND LEFT SO QUICKLY THAT SHE DID NOT NOTICE ANYTHING IN HIS HANDS. I THEN ASKED IF SHE SAW ANY WEAPONS. CARROLL TOLD ME THAT SHE DID NOT.

CARROLL TOLD ME THAT SHE WAS HIRED BY GUKISEN AND RICHTER TO BE THEIR NANNY AND THAT SHE HAD JUST STARTED WORKING FOR THEM THIS WEEK. CARROLL TOLD ME THAT SHE DID NOT KNOW THEM PRIOR TO WORKING FOR THEM. CARROLL HAD NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT THIS MATTER.

I CONCLUDED MY INTERVIEW WITH CARROLL AT THIS TIME. FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT THIS INCIDENT, SEE OFFICER STONE'S ORIGINAL REPORT TO THIS SUPPLEMENT.

On 2/3/11 I was assigned this case for review. The original report was taken by Ofc. Stone who reported that on 01/26/11 at approximately 1408 hours the victim, John Tavernaro, a Superior Court Process Server, had been assaulted by the homeowner, Dan Gukeisen, at his home, 1119 E. Riviera Dr., Tempe. Tavernaro had been at the Gukeisen residence for a civil service of official Superior Court documents when Gukeisen arrived home. Tavernaro approached Gukeisen in the driveway and as Gukeisen turned, he recognized Tavernaro from a previous civil service and immediately retreated inside the residence. Tavernaro followed to the front porch to serve the court paperwork when Gukeisen came back outside holding a black semi-automatic handgun.

Gukeisen then grabbed ahold of Tavernaro's left arm and held the muzzle of the firearm to Tavernaro's neck just below his left ear, pushing him over the retaining wall of the front porch. Gukeisen yelled at Tavernaro saying, "We told you not to come back. If you move I'll blow you head off". Gukeisen finally let Tavernaro up and removed the gun from his neck after Tavernaro told Gukeisen numerous times he was going to get in trouble for threatening a Civil Servant with a gun. Gukeisen was not home or refused to come out of the house when police arrived. For further details, refer to Ofc. Stone's report.

On 2/3/11 I located two prior reports: 10-145522 & 10-146716, on 9/20/10 & 9/22/10, when Tavernaro went to Gukeisen's residence in an attempt to serve official documents. On 09/22/10, Tavernaro did serve the documents to Gukeisen and his wife, Kim Richter, with police assistance. Both Gukeisen and Richter were home at the time of this service and were very angry at Tavernaro for being on their property and had called Tempe Police. While police were present, Richter pushed Tavernaro into the retaining wall on the front porch, yelling at him to get off their property. Tavernaro did not wish to aid in prosecution at that time because he was concerned because Richter had a small child at home and he did not want to separate her from her child (Tavernaro advised me of this information when I spoke with him on 2/9/11). For further details, refer to IR #10-146716.

On 2/3/11, I received the photographs from the incident for review. I observed that Tavernaro had an approximate 3" abrasion on his right elbow that appeared to be consistent with being scraped on a cement block wall surface. Tavernaro also had a round shaped red mark which was consistent to the approximate size of the muzzle to a semi-automatic handgun. Tavernaro also had a gold chain that was broken during the assault which is pictured in the photographs. Additional photographs were taken by patrol of the numerous No Trespassing signs on and around the property.

[REDACTED] Det. Adams advised me to contact the lead attorney, Paul Kittridge, for filing purposes and further information. I emailed Paul Kittridge with this report information and he acknowledged the information.

On 2/9/11 I contacted Tavernaro who told me the following. Tavernaro said he has been a process server for Arizona Superior Court for over 18 years and had been to Gukeisen's residence prior to this incident, on 9/20/10 and 9/22/10. Tavernaro stated on 9/20/10, he was there to serve civil documents and no one was home, however he believed someone was in the residence, refusing to answer the door. Tavernaro said he returned on 9/22/10 to attempt re-service and a Tempe Police Officer came to the residence because the occupants had called complaining about someone trespassing. Tavernaro said he had observed the no trespassing signs posted at the residence, and knew he was in his legal right, as a process server acting in a legal capacity, to be at the residence, out front, to serve legal documents. Tavernaro stated he had his Superior Court Identification and presented it to Tempe Police. Tavernaro said he then asked the Tempe Officers to stand by with him while he served the papers. Tempe dispatch then called Lisa Richter back, as she had called initially to report the trespasser, and asked her to come to the door for the paperwork. Tavernaro stated that Daniel Gukeisen opened the door with a young child and then Richter came running out yelling at Tavernaro to get off their property and "body blocked" him into the retaining block wall. I asked Tavernaro what he meant by "body blocked" and he said "she pushed me in the chest area with her arms extended, mostly with one arm, shoving me hard, backwards. Tavernaro said he would have fallen over if not for the cement wall behind him. Tavernaro said Richter was extremely upset and the Officers stepped in and separated everyone. Tavernaro put the papers down on the porch area and told both Gukeisen and Richter that they had been served. Tavernaro said the officers then asked if he was willing to aid for assault, but Tavernaro said he did not wish to at that time. Tavernaro told me when I talked to him now that he did not want to have her charged because he did not want her to go to jail with the young child at home. Since this incident, Tavernaro stated he now wished to aid in prosecution for the assault which occurred on 9/22/10. For further details, refer to Tempe IR#10-146716.

Tavernaro said on 1/26/11 at approximately 1320 hours, he arrived at Gukeisen and Richter's residence and parked approximately 3 houses away. Tavernaro stated he walked up to the residence and attempted to make contact but no one answered the door. Tavernaro decided to return to his vehicle and wait to see if the Gukeisen and Richter would return soon. Approximately 20 minutes later at 1340 hours, Tavernaro stated he saw a smaller white pick-up truck arrive at the residence and park on the street, but in front of the gated driveway. Tavernaro said he got out of his vehicle and started to walk toward the house and recognized Daniel Gukeisen and Kim Richter as the occupants of the vehicle as they exited. Tavernaro said Richter immediately walked into the house and Gukeisen remained in the driveway area and appeared to be looking at the roof. Tavernaro stated he walked through the open side gate and approached Gukeisen, who turned and recognized Tavernaro. Tavernaro said he told Gukeisen, "I have more papers for you", and Gukeisen immediately retreated inside the house. Tavernaro said he walked to the front porch and announced, "You and your wife have been served" as he placed the papers beside the front door.

Tavernaro said before he could turn around to leave, Gukeisen exited the residence and had a black colored handgun in his right hand. Tavernaro said Gukeisen grabbed hold of his left arm with his

left hand and spun Tavernaro around. Gukeisen then put the muzzle of the handgun to Tavernaro's neck, just below his left ear and held him against and bent over the cement block retaining wall on the front porch. Tavernaro said Gukeisen said, "We told you not to come back" and if he moved he would "blow my head off". Tavernaro said Gukeisen was very angry and he felt scared for his life that Gukeisen was going to kill him.

Tavernaro said he told Gukeisen in a very calm voice that he needed to let him go and that he was going to get in a lot of trouble threatening a civil servant with the courts with a firearm. Tavernaro said Gukeisen seemed out of control and kept telling him they were calling the police and holding him there because he was trespassing and he had the right to do whatever he needed to do. Tavernaro said he pleaded with Gukeisen for what seemed like 2-3 minutes, repeating that he needed to let him go and that he was making a "big mistake" and was in "deep do-do". Tavernaro said Gukeisen told him to "shut up" and tried to force him on his knees, but Tavernaro said he struggled to hold himself against the wall as he did not want to be in an "execution style" position with a gun at his neck.

After what seemed like 2-3 minutes of this, Tavernaro said Gukeisen seemed to think about what he was doing and stood back and spun Tavernaro around, now holding the muzzle of the gun under Tavernaro's chin and grabbed onto the front of his shirt. Tavernaro said Gukeisen said, "I'll take the gun down and you are leaving now". Tavernaro said Gukeisen then removed the gun from his chin, and was still holding onto his shirt, telling him "You are leaving". At this time Richter came out of the house and appeared to be on the phone with police. Gukeisen yelled at her and told her to go back inside several times until she finally did. Tavernaro said he told Gukeisen he was going to call the police and wait for them and was not going to leave. Tavernaro said Gukeisen seemed very angry and finally let go of him and went inside the house.

Tavernaro said he walked out to the street and called 9-1-1. Tavernaro said while he was on the phone with the 9-1-1 operator he saw Richter exit the house and leave in the small white pick-up truck. Tavernaro said he did not see Gukeisen, to his knowledge, exit the house and enter the vehicle. Tavernaro said when the police arrived, someone pointed out to him that his gold chain was dangling from his shirt. Tavernaro said the chain must have been pulled and broken when Gukeisen grabbed onto his shirt front and was holding the gun under his chin. Tavernaro added that the chain had an expensive Jade "Budda" figure that he had bought when he was stationed with the military in the Orient. The "Budda" was described as oval shaped, 1/2" thick and 1-3/4" tall X 1-1/2" wide, green jade, worth approximately \$1800-\$2000. The 24K gold chain had a broken link which was estimated at \$50 to repair. Tavernaro indicated that he obtained photographs of abrasions on his neck he sustained when the chain was broken, since he did not think the officer at the scene had at the time.

Besides the abrasions to his neck, Tavernaro stated his right elbow and forearm was scratched up and sore. He also said he had a red mark which was tender on the left side of his neck, just under his ear where Gukeisen had held the muzzle of the firearm. Tavernaro said the mark stayed for a several hours after the incident. Tavernaro added that he had had recent surgery to his abdomen, at his belly button, in December and there had been a 2-3" incision which had been in the process of healing. Tavernaro stated that he had just been to the doctor on Monday (1/24/11) and the Doctor had advised him the incision was healing nicely, however he wore a bandage over the incision as it still was seeping. After the incident on 1/26/11 with Gukeisen, Tavernaro said when he checked the bandage later, it was saturated. Tavernaro saw a surgeon on 1/28/11 and was advised that the incision was now opened and causing additional drainage, however there was no infection. Tavernaro said he was advised by the surgeon to take precaution with any physical activity until the incision healed back again. Tavernaro stated as of 2/9/11,

the incision was healing "nicely", however he had been very concerned at the time of the incident.

Tavernaro said he remained at the scene while the police tried to contact Gukeisen, but he did not come out of the house, nor did the police go into the house. Tavernaro said he thought two women came out of the house that were employees, but he did not see Gukeisen. Tavernaro said he had no further information at this time. Tavernaro was willing to aid in prosecution.

While reviewing the supplemental reports, Ofc. Morris advised she had spoken to a Susan Stewart who advised she was employed by Kim Richter and that her office is inside the residence. Stewart said she and the other female, Margaret Carroll, Kim's nanny, were both inside the home office when they heard yelling. Stewart said she heard Kim yelling "Get off my property". Stewart said she never came out of the office; however she heard Kim and Dan leave a short time later. Stewart said Kim did not tell her she was leaving, but that was not unusual. Stewart said she has worked for Kim since 2008 and during that time she has never seen any firearms inside the residence. Stewart had nothing further.

Ofc. Camiliere contacted the nanny, Margaret White who said she had been home and had heard someone ringing the door bell earlier but she did not answer it. At approximately 1400 hours, Kim and Dan came home and she heard someone yelling, "Get off my property. I'm calling the Police." Carroll said she heard someone else say something like, "You have been served." Carroll said both Kim and Dan came inside the house and Dan started looking for something in the closet, and was knocking things off the top shelf. Dan then went into the bedroom with Kim and they both came out a short time later. Carroll said Dan went back outside and Kim followed shortly, telling Carroll to lock the front door after her. Carroll said both Dan and Kim left the house and she did not know where they went. Carroll told Ofc. Camiliere that Dan walked by so fast that she could not tell if he had anything in his hands when he came out of the bedroom. Carroll said she had only been hired as a nanny in the last week and she did not know them prior to her position as their nanny. Carroll had nothing further.

It should also be noted that Ofc. Stone added in his report that Sgt. Williams, the supervisor on scene during the original call was contacted by legal counsel for Kim Richter after numerous attempts to contact her and Gukeisen by police. The lawyer identified himself as Tim Hinsey from Gallagher and Kennedy at (602) 530-8592. Hinzy advised Sgt. Williams his client could only be contacted through him regarding this issue.

Based on the circumstances and physical evidence of injury to the victim, this case will be turned over to Maricopa County Attorney Paul Kittridge for review of the following charges against Daniel Gukeisen:
