THE GRAND JURY, for the County of Jefferson, State of Texas, duly selected, empanelled, sworn, charged, and organized as such at the January Term A.D. 2016, of the Criminal District Court for said County, upon their oaths present in and to said Court at said term that WILLIAM RALPH LAYNE WALKER, hereinafter styled Defendant, beginning on or about October 18, 2005, and continuing until on or about January 6, 2014, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County and said State aforesaid, did then and there, pursuant to one scheme or continuing course of conduct, while a public servant, namely: a person elected as an officer, employee, or agent of government, namely: presiding judge of the 252nd District Court of Jefferson County, Texas, and with intent to obtain a benefit, namely: personal, non-governmental services, intentionally and knowingly misuse government property, government services, government personnel, and things of value belonging to the government, namely: a computer, a printer, Ann Landry, Kim Carter, Tiffany DeCuir, Debbie Usoff, and the time of said government personnel, that had come into Defendant's custody and possession by virtue of his office and employment, and the aggregate value of the use of the things misused was \$1,500 or more but less than \$20,000.
