Quieter neighbourhoods and Cycleways update

The triangle in Palmers Green is has now reopened and work is nearly complete on the A105 scheme, but there are still several sections that need completed. There is also some re-work happening in Winchmore hill to widen the footways as they have been shown to be too narrow.

The consultations have now closed on the Fernleigh Road and Fox Lane Quieter Neighbourhoods as well as the Latymer Road to Edmonton Green quiet way.

We are broadly supportive of the quieter neighbourhood principals, but we wish they had done further and the effects will need to be monitored. There are

several elements we are really pleased to see including continuous footways to give pedestrians priority, 20mph streets and school streets.
