LOWER THAMES CROSSING CONSULTATION

We have been looking at the possible impact of this major project on Havering. One significant issue is that new slip roads by-pass the roundabout at the A127/M25 junction but currently, there are no visible facilities to allow walkers and cyclists making their way along the A 127 to cross. (well spotted Philip!)

Another point is that there does not appear to be any plan to provide a bicycle crossing service as there is at the Dartford Crossing.
