WHAT DO I DO?

Have your children watch the Leadership Video, *I Tell Others About Jesus*.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR THIS LESSON:

- Ask your children the Leadership Questions.
- Read the Leadership Story, found in Luke 3:1-22, to your children.
- Do the Optional Family Activity.

OPTIONAL FAMILY ACTIVITY: FAMILY QUIZ

In order to tell others about Jesus, your children will need some basic facts about Jesus. Help them learn these facts by playing a memorization game. These are the facts that your children will need to memorize.

- Jesus loves me.
- Jesus will forgive me.
- Jesus is alive.

Work to memorize the facts by saying them aloud repeatedly, making up motions, or incorporating them into a song.

Once your children feel they know the facts, quiz them. Leave out words and have the person fill in the blank. (Jesus loves ____.) Or ask each child to say all the facts. Continue to quiz the children on the facts when you are driving to school or at mealtimes. Before long, your children will be able to tell others about Jesus using these three facts!

MEMORY VERSE:

Help your children memorize this verse.

"Jesus said to the people who believed in him, 'You are truly my disciples if you remain faithful to my teachings.'"

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Main Point: I Tell Others About Jesus!

Child Leadership Questions:

1. What did Agent tell Moviestar was the best thing ever?
(A Wonder Phone.)
2. Who told Moviestar that the Wonder Phone was not the best thing ever?
(Propmaster.)
3. Propmaster told Moviestar about the best thing ever. Who did Prop Master say was the best thing ever?
(Jesus.)
4. In the Bible Story, Zechariah and Elizabeth did not have any children. What did the angel tell them?
(They would have a son and they should name him John.)
5. John lived in the wilderness and traveled to tell people about Jesus. What things did John tell the people?
(Get baptized. Live the way God wanted them to. Be sorry for the things they did wrong.)
6. At the end of the Bible Story, who came to be baptized by John?
(Jesus.)
7. John spent his whole life telling others about Jesus and God wants you to do the same. You can tell others about Jesus just like John did. Who can you tell about Jesus?
(Grandparents. Friends. Teachers. Other family members.)
