### LEADERSHIP TRAIT - GOOD CHOICES

Great leaders always chose to do what is right.

### LEADERSHIP GOAL

The children will learn that they should choose to do what God says is right.

### LEADERSHIP LESSON

David Spares Saul's Life-  
*1 Samuel 26*

### WHAT DO I DO?

Have your children watch the Leadership Video, *I Will Do What Is Right*.

### ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR THIS LESSON

- Ask your children the Leadership Questions.
- Read the Leadership Story, found in 1 Samuel 26, to your children.
- Do the Optional Family Activity.

### OPTIONAL FAMILY ACTIVITY: RULES OF THE GAME

Materials Needed: an age-appropriate board game

Ask your children to play a board game with you. Remind them that doing what is right means we follow God's rules. Tell them that you are going to practice doing what is right by playing by the rules of this game.

Explain the rules of the game to your children. Then, ask the following question:

Those are the rules of the game, but what are some things that we could choose to do that are not right? (*Throw the game board or pieces. Not let someone else take a turn.*)

Say: Choosing to do those things would not be right and the game would not be as fun. The best way to play the game is to do what is right by following the rules. Let's play the game.

At the end of the game, congratulate your family for doing what is right by following the rules of the game. In our lives, we do what is right by following God's rules. Just like the game was better when we did what was right, our lives will be better when we follow God's rules.

### MEMORY VERSE:

Help your children memorize this verse.

*"Do what is right and good in the LORD's sight, so all will go well with you."*

*Deuteronomy 6:18a (NLT)*



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**Main Point:** I Will Do What Is Right!

### Child Leadership Questions:

1. What stopped Switch and Bivvy from moving up the mountain?  
*(A big pile of rocks.)*
2. What did Miss Skye tell Switch and Bivvy to do with the rocks?  
*(Move them out of the path, one at a time.)*
3. What did Switch and Bivvy do with the rocks?  
*(Threw them down the side of the mountain.)*
4. Miss Skye found out what Switch and Bivvy were doing and told them a Bible Lesson to help them learn about doing what is right. Who did what was right in the Bible Lesson.  
*(David.)*
5. Who was chasing David?  
*(King Saul.)*
6. When Saul was asleep, David and his friend went into Saul's camp. What did David's friend want him to do?  
*(Hurt Saul while he slept.)*
7. David knew that it was wrong to hurt Saul. Did David chose to hurt Saul or did he choose to do something else?  
*(He chose to do something else.)*

David's friend wanted him to do something wrong, but David would not do it. You can be like David and do what is right even if someone else wants you to do the wrong thing.
