OPTIONAL FAMILY ACTIVITY: SET IT UP

This week, get everyone in the family involved in helping with your dinner prep and table setting.

Make a chart that has table setting and dinner prep duties for each person in the family. Instruct your family on how to set the table and give each person a specific job. Each night right before dinner, check the chart to see how everyone did at helping to set the table and getting ready for dinner.

You can remind your family that when everyone takes a small job and helps each other, the jobs don't seem to be as big. And helping others is also something God wants us to do.

Main Point: I Will Help Others!

Child Leadership Questions:

1. What did Suzie and Bill want do on their Epic Toy Adventure in the jungle?
(Build a treehouse.)
2. Snarlie did not want to help build the treehouse in the jungle. What did he want to do instead?
(Run around.)
3. Suzie and Bill told Snarlie a Bible Lesson to help him learn about helping others. Who was the man in the Bible Lesson who helped others?
(Moses.)
4. How did Moses help others?
(He helped the Israelites leave Egypt.)
5. Did Pharaoh want to let the Israelites leave Egypt?
(No.)
6. When Moses and the Israelites got to the sea and the Egyptian army was chasing them, what did Moses do?
(He prayed and God told him to put his hand over the sea.)
7. What happened to the sea?
(God sent wind to blow the water apart and the Israelites walked across on dry land!)
8. Did Moses keep helping the people of Israel after they got out of Egypt?
(Yes.)

Just like Moses helped the people of Israel leave Egypt, we can help the people around us. We just need to look for ways that we can help as we go through our day.
