LEADERSHIP GOAL

The children will learn that we can have peace because God is taking care of us.

LEADERSHIP LESSON

Sermon on the Mount - Matthew 6:25-34

WHAT DO I DO?

Have your children watch the Leadership Video, *God Will Take Care Of Me*.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR THIS LESSON

- Ask your children the Leadership Ouestions.
- Read the Leadership Story, found in Matthew 6:25-34, to your children.
- Do the Optional Family Activity.

OPTIONAL FAMILY AGTIVITYS NATURE WALK

Go on a nature walk with your family and look for flowers and birds. Take along a notebook or journal to record what you see. You could count the number of flowers and birds you see, or you could draw pictures of what you see along the way.

After the walk, talk about the Bible Lesson in Matthew 6:25-34 where Jesus says that God takes care of the birds and flowers. Remind your family that God will take care of us like He takes care of the birds and flowers that you saw on your nature walk.

*Optional - While on the nature walk, take a picture of a flower and a bird to put in a frame or on the fridge to remind us that God will take care of us. Decorate the frame with the words, "God will take care of us."

Help your children memorize this verse.

Main Point: God Will Take Care Of Me!

Child Leadership Questions:

- 1. What warning sign did Switch and Bivvy see at the bottom of the mountain? (A sign telling about the dangers of mountain climbing.)
- 2. What warnings were on the sign? (Falling rocks. Bad weather. Wild animals)
- 3. What happened after Switch and Bivvy saw the warning sign? (They got worried. They didn't want to go up the mountain anymore.)
- 4. Switch and Bivvy called Miss Skye who told them that they needed to have peace. What Bible Lesson did she share to help them understand this?

 (Jesus telling about how God takes care of the birds and flowers.)
- 5. What did Jesus say the birds and flowers do not worry about? (Food and clothing.)
- 6. What did Jesus say we should do instead of worrying? (Have peace and know that God will take care of us.)

Jesus taught that the birds and flowers did not worry about the things they needed and we should not either. Instead of worrying, we should have peace knowing that God will take care of us.
