LEADERSHIP TRAIT - SENSE OF PURPOSE

Understanding God has created everything helps a leader know that they have a place in the world and that God has a plan and purpose for them.

LEADERSHIP LESSON

Your children will learn that God made light.

LEADERSHIP STORY

The creation of light. (*Genesis 1:1-5*)

MEMORY VERSE

Help your children memorize this verse.

"Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good." Genesis 1:31a (NLT)

First:

Read the Leadership Story about the creation of light from Genesis 1:1-5 to your children.

Next:

Let your children watch The Leadership Video, *God Made Light*.

Then:

Ask your children the Child Leadership Questions, and lead your family through the Optional Family Activity.



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CONTINUED

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Child Leadership Questions:

1. God did something and then there was light. How did God create light?
(He spoke and there was light.)
2. God made a name for the light, and a name for the dark. What is it called when it is light outside?
(Day.)
3. What is it called when it is dark outside?
(Night.)
4. Did God say light was good, or did He say it was bad?
(He said it was good.)

OPTIONAL FAMILY ACTIVITY: LIGHTS OFF

Play a game of Lights Off with your child this week. Have them turn a light switch on, and then tell you something that they can do when it's light. Then, have them turn the light off and tell you something they can do when it's dark. Repeat this with different lights throughout your house. Then, ask the questions below.

- What were some of the things that we could do in the light?
(Play. Read together. Draw.)
- What were some of the things that we could do in the dark?
(Sleep. Play hide and seek.)

God made the light and the dark and said that they are good. We can thank God for giving us light and dark.
