LEADERSHIP TRAIT - SENSE OF PURPOSE

Understanding God has created everything helps a leader know that they have a place in the world and that God has a plan and purpose for them.

LEADERSHIP LESSON

Your children will learn that God made all people different, and that's a good thing.

LEADERSHIP STORY

The creation of people. (Genesis 1:26-31)

MEMORY VERSE

Help your children memorize this verse.

"Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good." Genesis 1:31a (NLT)

First:

Read the Leadership Story about the creation of people from Genesis 1:26-31 to your children.

Next:

Let your children watch The Leadership Video, God Made People.

Then:

Ask your children the Child Leadership Questions, and lead your family through the Optional Family Activity.

Child Leadership Questions:

- 1. Who created people? (God.)
- 2. God made people to reign over what things on earth? (Fish in the sea. Birds in the sky. Wild animals. Small animals.)
- 3. Did God create all of the people to look the same? (No.)
- 4. What did God see when He looked over His creation on the sixth day? (*That it was good.*)
- 5. Think of your best friend. If God had not made people, would you have a best friend? (No.)
- 6. Is it good that God made people different from each other? (Yes.)

OPTIONAL FAMILY ACTIVITY: PEOPLE WATCH

Go to a crowded place with your children this week. Watch the people together, then talk about all the ways they are different. Point out different heights, different skin colors, different hair lengths, etc. Then discuss how God made all of us to be different and special, and how He loves us very much.

- Did everyone you see look the same? (No.)
- What was different about them. (Some were taller. Some had shorter hair. Their skin colors were different.)

God made people and said they were very good. We can thank God for making all different kinds of people.
