



## I Will Learn From Jesus!

### From Power Up Jr. Lesson 1

#### LEADERSHIP TRAIT - WISDOM

Strong leaders understand the value of gaining wisdom from the Bible.

#### LEADERSHIP LESSON

Your children will find out that they can learn from Jesus.

#### LEADERSHIP STORY

Calling of the disciples. (*Matthew 4:18 - 20, Luke 5 & 6*)

#### MEMORY VERSE

Help your children memorize this verse.

*"Do what is right and good in the LORD's sight, so all will go well with you." Deuteronomy 6:18a (NLT)*

#### First:

Read the Leadership Story to your children. The Leadership Story for this lesson is about Jesus calling the disciples and is found in Matthew 4:18 - 20 and Luke 5:1 - 11, 27 - 28 and 6:12 - 16.

#### Next:

Watch the Leadership Video, *I Will Learn From Jesus*, with your family.

#### Then:

Complete the Child Leadership Questions, and lead your family through the Optional Family Activity.

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#### Child Leadership Questions:

Where can you find the story of Jesus?

*(In the Bible.)*

What was Jesus teaching people?

*(About God and how God loved them. About the good rules God had for people's lives.)*

People were learning from Jesus as He taught! Then, Jesus began to call some men to follow Him and learn from Him. What did Jesus say to the two fishermen?

*(Come, follow me.)*

Those fishermen followed Jesus and learned from Him. How many men did Jesus call to be His disciples?

*(Twelve.)*

How did the disciples learn from Jesus?

*(Following Jesus. Spending time with Jesus.)*

The disciples were able to spend time with Jesus and learn from Him. We can learn from Jesus by going to church and reading the Bible with our family.

#### OPTIONAL FAMILY ACTIVITY: HEART LESSON

Your children learned that the disciples were called by Jesus and began to follow Him. While they followed Jesus, the disciples learned from Him. We need to learn from Jesus, too. Have family members draw a large heart on a piece of paper together. Take turns drawing pictures of ways we can learn from Jesus. You might draw a picture of a Bible or of your family going to church. By each picture, write down one lesson you can or have learned when you did each thing. When the heart is finished, explain that we should use what we learn from God to help us in our lives. Use the things you learn by doing what is right and continuing to grow more like Jesus! Place the heart somewhere in your house to remind your family to learn from Jesus just like the disciples did.
