# Exam Strategy

  - Be sure to manage your time well to be sure each question has an equal chance at being answered.

**Marking questions for later review**

**To mark a question**  
Click the **Mark** button.

**MARK**

**To unmark a question**  
Click the **Mark** button. This button will only appear if you have marked the question.

**MARKED**

Unmark each question when you are satisfied with your answer choice. If you forget to unmark the question, it's OKAY. The scoring process does not differentiate between marked and unmarked questions.

You can also leave a question unanswered (incomplete). Marked and Incomplete questions will be highlighted in a Review Questions screen before you exit the exam, and you will have the opportunity to go back to those if you have time remaining.

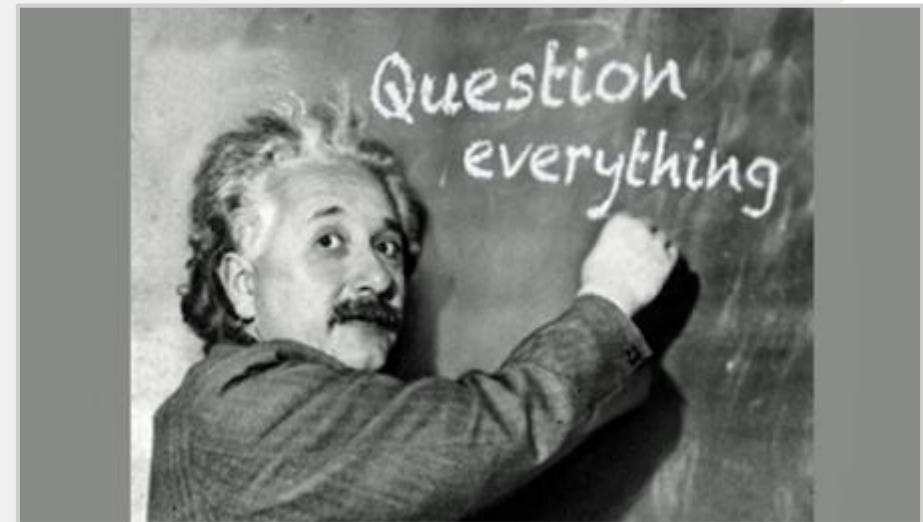
# Exam Strategy

3. Review marked questions
  - Write on paper the question number and ABCD
  - Look for what is false and cross through those letters
  - Process of elimination and time should help
4. Write out on scratch paper tables or formulas as required
5. Make sure all questions are answered
6. Review all answers if you have time
  - Don't change the answer unless you see a word you have missed the first time like "is not" instead of "is"

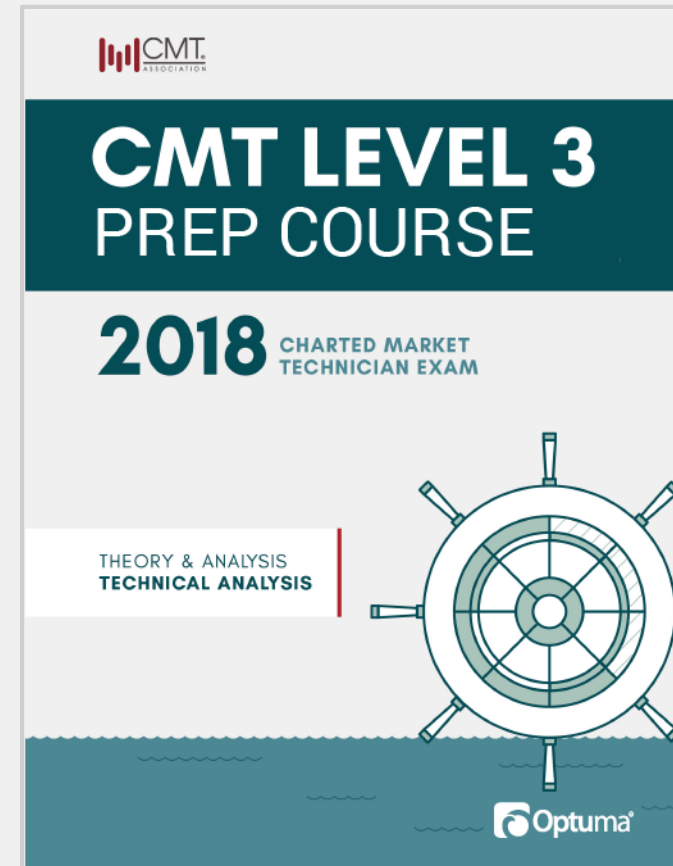
