What are my payment options as a University of Tampa Student?

- 1) University of Tampa Direct bill: www.ut.edu/cpaprep/ (See info below)

How do I register?

Your first step will be to go to www.ut.edu/cpaprep/ click "sign up and pay to make your payment of \$2,980 (that's over \$400 off the full course tuition*) for Becker's CPA Exam Review to the University of Tampa. Once you have placed your payment; to register/ order your materials, you'll need go to www.Becker.com/UTampa or call Becker's customer service number at (877) CPA-EXAM (877-272-3926). You will need to provide your UT e-mail address as validation that you are an UT student. Becker will be invoicing UT and you will not be required to pay at registration unless you choose to purchase any additional products (i.e. Flashcards etc.).

We recommend that you select the UT Live class for your class schedule, which will be held on Saturdays in the spring which begins on January 16, 2016. www.Becker.com/schedules > Choose Tampa from the Live Class drop down menu and select the University of Tampa.

You'll receive login information shortly following your registration that will give you access to your e-books and software, and your text books will arrive soon after (depending on when you have indicated you'll be sitting for each portion of the exam).
