<h3>Things Adam Knew About God</h3> <h4>Hiram Kemp</h4> <p>Bible students often wonder what it would be like to speak with the people we read about in Scripture. What would Moses say about the Red Sea parting or receiving the Law on Sinai? How thrilling—and dangerous—might it have been to travel with Paul on his missionary journeys?</p> <p>One person in Scripture with a unique perspective would be Adam. As the first man, Adam knew the world in its original perfection and lived before sin entered the picture (Genesis 1–2). His life spans the first five chapters of Genesis, and he lived 930 years (Genesis 5:5). From the text, here are a few things Adam knew about God:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Adam knew God was good (Genesis 1:1–31). Adam saw God’s goodness in creation—everything God made was “very good.” He also experienced God’s generosity when given Eve as a companion (Genesis 2:18-25). The God Adam knew was kind, benevolent, and provided freely for his creation (James 1:17). Adam would remind us that our God is always blessing our lives with our needs and even some of our wants (cf. 1 Timothy 6:17).Adam knew God valued humanity (Genesis 1:26–27). Of all God made, only humans were created in His image (Genesis 2:7, 5:2). Adam knew that he, Eve, and later their children were special in God’s eyes. Human life is sacred and uniquely reflects God’s image in a way nothing else in creation can.Adam knew God has rules (Genesis 2:16–17). God gave Adam and Eve the garden to enjoy, but He commanded them not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Some question why the tree was placed there at all, but that misses the point. As Creator, God has full authority over His creation. He can permit or forbid as He chooses. Rather than question God's rules, we are wiser to obey them (Psalm 145:17).Adam knew God was serious about sin (Genesis 3:1–19). God warned that disobedience would bring death, and it did. Though God never desired this outcome, He made the consequences of sin clear. Yet even in judgment, God offered hope. In Genesis 3:15, we see the first promise of a coming Savior. Adam would have known in part what we now know fully: God is serious about sin—but just as serious about saving us from it (2 Corinthians 5:21, 8:9)!
