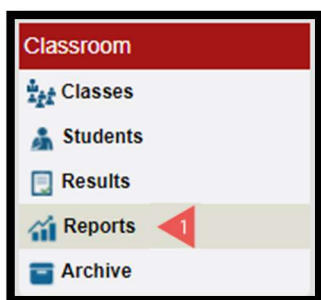
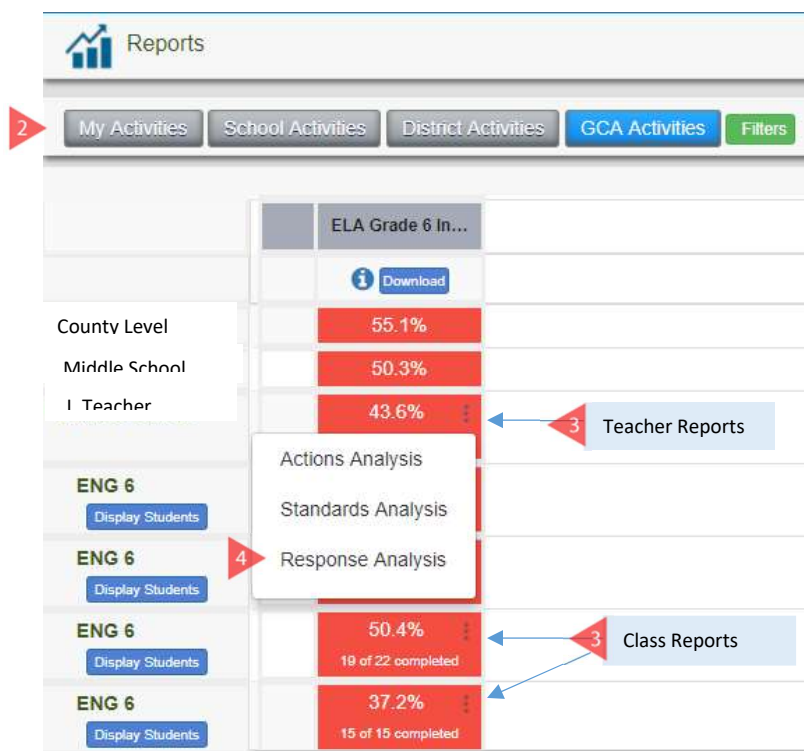


Response Analysis Reports For Teachers

The Response Analysis Report allows teachers to view the distribution of student responses along with any feedback for each response or scored item.



1. Click on Reports from the left menu.



2. Select the appropriate reporting tab for the selected Activity.
3. Click on the ellipsis at the teacher or class level.
4. Select Response Analysis Report

Response Analysis Reports For Teachers



- Buttons will appear at the top of the report that correspond with the student actions on the activity. This activity has two item types, Student Choice and Student Response. Each Action type has a detailed report. This view displays Student Choice responses.
- Open in Tab button allows for a full screen view.
Reports can be printed by using the computer browser with this view.
- The Preview button displays the student's view of the activity.
- Click on the underline Action for a detailed view of the item.
- Click on underlined student total to view a list of students that selected each response.
