Teachers Accessing Action Analysis

Action Analysis Reports allow teachers to view comparative data at the district, school and teacher level for items or tasks, called actions, within an activity. Teachers may drill down to the individual class level to view analysis data, as well as, students' response data.

1. Select Reports from left menu.
2. Select type of report you want to view: District Activities, School Activities or GCA Activities button.
3. For teacher level reports, click on the vertical ellipsis for desired Assesslet in the teacher's row.
4. Select Action Analysis.

- Partial - Number of responses that received Partial Credit
- Correct - Number of correct responses.

6. View Action performance at the district level.

7. View Action performance school level.

8. View Action performance teacher or class level.


9. Open results in the "Open in tab" to print results using computer browser.

10. Select Preview button to view an Assesslet.

11. View color-coded data bars for quick comparison.

- Red represents % of incorrect responses
- Yellow represents % of responses that received partial credit (Does not apply to multiple choice items)
- Green represents % of correct responses.
